French Revolution- Selfie Assignment

How to take a selfie



Task:

You will place yourself into an event from the French Revolution. Your event must connect to a cause, event or moment at the beginning of the French Revolution.

You will then take your “French Revolution Selfie” and put it on Google Slides with comments on what the image is and why is it significant..

Directions:

1. Open Photobooth and click “effects”.
2. Choose the 5th dot at the bottom or scroll to the right with the arrow.
3. Keep photo booth open.
4. Open a web browser and search the cause, event or moment of the French Revolution. Consider the following options:
 - a. **Causes** of the French Revolution (unfair taxes, poor harvests/starvation, Enlightenment, American Revolution, unfair social class system, weak ruler of King Louis XVI)
 - b. spectator at the execution of King Louis XVI
 - c. **Event/moment:** Guillotine spectator
 - d. **Event/moment:** Storming of the Bastille
 - e. **Event/moment:** Marie Antoinette’s lavish spending (clothing, Palace of Versailles)
5. Choose an image in which you could superimpose yourself.
6. Right click on the image and save it to your desktop.
7. Drag the image from the desktop to the “user backdrop”.
8. Follow the photo booth directions and take a selfie!
