The Junior Marshal Experience



The Junior Marshal Experience at Heritage High School is an exciting opportunity for students to be part of a distinguished group whose focus is excellence and decorum. They will represent their junior class in service to the school and, most importantly, the senior class during their most significant and formal occasion of their high school journey.

Application Eligibility Criteria

Juniors who are selected will represent Heritage High School at several events. Students are selected based on the evidence of merit, positive character, and service to others. Juniors will be required to take on a leadership role, complete hours of service and volunteerism. In addition, Applicants must have:

- Have at least a 4.00 Weighted grade point average and must maintain a minimum weighted 4.0 GPA for the remainder of the school year.
- Show evidence of consistent extracurricular involvement at Heritage HS
- Demonstrate the highest level of integrity in all classes, no major discipline infractions; i.e. ISS or OSS, Honor Code violation, etc.
- Be exemplary models of RISK: Respect, Integrity, Self-Discipline and Kindness
- Possess and utilize quick thinking, problem solving skills and take initiative
- Be attentive during all required ceremonies, and guests during any event
- Must be able to attend ALL assigned events which includes, rehearsals, graduations and other designated activities/ events as follows:
 - 1. January 21, 2025 Mid-Year Graduation Rehearsal at 8:30am
 - 2. January 31, 2025 Mid-Year Graduation Ceremony at 9:00am
 - 3. Thursday, May 29, 2025 Senior Day & Graduation Rehearsal
 - 4. Friday, May 30, 2025 School Awards Ceremony
 - Tuesday, June 16, 2025 June Commencement Ceremony @ Raleigh Convention Center
 - 6. *And other duties as assigned; i.e. Curriculm Fair/Meet the Teacher Night, etc.

The Junior Marshal Experience 1

Being a Junior Marshal is an honor and a highly selective process. Thirty (30) juniors from the Class of 2026 will be selected to serve as a Junior Marshal. If you meet 100% of the criteria and are willing and able to participate in this cohort of excellence and decorum, you are invited to submit an application to be considered. Remember, your commitment is critical. If you anticipate conflicts with any of the dates above, you should resist the urge to submit an application. While dates for events are already in place, they are subject to change due to weather, pandemic, or other circumstances. If that happens you will be alerted of the change and possible reschedule. Selected Marshals will still need to make themselves available in the event of date changes. **Remember** - 100% participation is required for all events, as this is a small group, and all members are needed to fulfill several duties.
