

Last Week of Camp Pixie Dust/End of Summer Sparkler

Star Week-9/4 to 10-This week also doubles as the End of Summer Sparkler! In order to make the star pixie dust, you will first need to complete a Tink quest about finding access to a location called the Starry Cliffs. After completing the quest, you will be able to access the location and collect a rare ingredient called Stardust which is used to create the final pixie dust bottle. The star dust is a material for a series of crafts. Those crafts are available as seasonal crafts (as well as the Starry Cliffs), for the rest of September.

Starry crafts (as well as additional ingredients):

- Star Cookies-Dulcie-Honeycombs, snowflakes, acorns, truffles, yellow gems, blue gems
- Talent Star Silly Sweet-Dulcie-Honeycombs, snowflakes, acorns, truffles, buttercups, lilies, feathers, yellow gems, blue gems, Pepper Black dye
- Crown of the Sea-Bobbin-Lilly petals
- Sash of Fire-Yellow gems
- Necklace of Stars-Mendy-Last light of day
- Bracelets of Frost-Mendy-Snowflakes
- Anklet of Moon-Mendy-Mermaids voice
- Slippers of the Sky-Mendy's-Feathers
- Silver Sceptor-Last light of day, mermaid's voice
- Rainbow Crystal-Buttercups, lilies, feathers, yellow gems, blue gems, Pepper Black dye, last light of day, mermaid's voice

Facts about the Tinkerbell Movies

First Movie

- Original designs of the main characters had Fawn wearing purple, Silvermist with blue eyes instead of brown and Iridessa with a crop top and ruffles on her top and skirt, rather than the sunflower dress. In earlier illustrations, Iridessa wore blue instead of yellow.
- The movie was originally going to be released in the fall of 2007 (a year before it actually released) and the plot was originally going to be very different. Basically what would happen is that Tink and her friends would finish training at Fairy Mary's school and would receive their pixie dust from Queen Clarion. But when Tink is deemed unready, she and her friends try to steal the pixie dust causing it to disappear. In order to save the world of imagination, the fairies embark on individual quests which would test their strengths.
- The original idea of the movie would have Peter Pan, the Lost Boys, Captain Hook, Mr. Smee and the other pirates. Some of the pirates were named Mullins, Wibbles, Turk, Black Murphy, Bill Jukes and Startay.
- Much of the plot would focus on an orphan girl in London named Victoria. There would be several other orphans there as well.
- At one point in the movie, Tink's friends would sacrifice their pixie dust to Tink causing them to disappear.

- Early concept art for the film depicts a dragon named George and a Sprite Island
- The voice cast was going to be very different with Brittany Murphy (as Tink), Cameron Boweb, Emma Hunton, Zach Shada and America Young. The only consistent voice actor was Kristin Chenoweth.
- Lets get away from this original concept and head to the version that actually came into fruition; Rosetta was originally going to teach Tink how to be a garden fairy
- One of Tink's inventions that never made it into the film which was a propelled contraption that would combine rain (sprinkled from a beehive I think) and light (from a mirror)

Lost Treasure

- The movie's plot is based off the 2007 book; Tink, North of Neverland
- An early illustration of Lyria depicted her with a pink and purple striped dress (sort of like the Cheshire Cat), a Shakesperian-like collar made out of a flower, and a lyre
- Blaze was originally going to say goodbye to Tink to return to his friends at the end of their adventure, but since John Lasseter liked him so much, Blaze returned to Pixie Hollow with Tink and Terrence

Great Fairy Rescue

- According to the teaser, it was Lizzy that wanted Tink to be in the museum
- The Minister of Summer was originally going to be in the movie
- When Dr. Griffiths was a boy, he actually saw a fairy, but he made the mistake of telling someone about it which caused everyone to rush to the oak tree where the fairy was with nets and lanterns. One person dropped a lantern causing a fire. His father accused him of being foolish and believing in fairies. This backstory was originally going to be the opening of the film, but it was deleted because it took away the quality of Tink and Lizzy meeting for the first time.
- The filmmakers interviewed five to nine year old girls and asked them what they would do if they met a fairy. Every one of them wanted to have a tea party, which is why Lizzy has a tea party with Tink.

Secret of the Wings

- The film was originally going to be called "Mysterious Winter Woods"

Pirate Fairy

- The movie was originally going to be called "Quest for the Queen". In the movie, a wicked rouge fairy named Zarina would send her orchid army to steal the blue pixie dust. Queen Clarion would get zapped trying to defend Tink, and the ministers inform her that the blue pixie dust is needed to heal her. Zarina ends up getting overthrown and the Queen is healed.

- The movie was originally going to open with Tink making a music box, which would be Queen Clarion's arrival day gift.
- The movie was originally going to feature a hermit who gives guidance
- Instead of the crocodile, animal-talent Rosetta was originally going to come across a boar.
- Zarina wasn't originally going to use the blue dust in her pixie dust alchemy. In fact, she discovers the light dust when she accidentally drops dust in the fire place. This leads to her experimenting.

Legend of the Neverbeast

- The idea of the movie's story actually came from the director's daughter who, just like Fawn, loves animals, especially very big dogs (which the director was afraid of). She told him that the bigger the animal is, the bigger the love they have to give.
- That daughter is actually named Callista. It could be possible that one of the rabbits Fawn trains (also named Callista) is based off of her
- Why does Fawn look so different in this movie compared to the other movies? Well, according to a deleted scene (the original opening), this was Fawn's look for the Animal Parade (where the animals that the animal fairies have been taking over go into the forest to live their lives). Vidia even comments in that scene about how different she looks.
- In the movie, Nyx, Fury and Chase all have spoken dialogue. However, the other two scouts, Di and Shade, were originally going to have spoken lines. In fact, Di (the one with the short red hair by the way) was originally going to be the comedic relief character of the group. However, the director thought the scouts would be better off as more silent.
- Instead of building the rock towers, Gruff was originally going to eat red rocks with metal in them. The metal in his mouth would absorb the lightning allowing him to transform.
- Gruff's design is a combination of all kinds of animals including but not limited to a hippo, rhino and tiger. Fawn described his species as a combination of opossum marsupialis and bison occidentalis (an extinct species of bison).
