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This band handbook has been compiled for the members and parents of the A.W. Spence Beginner Band. The purpose of this handbook is to provide information regarding the various activities, policies, procedures and expectations of the A.W. Spence Band program.

All band members and parents are to read the entire handbook carefully to gain a clear understanding of the expectations set for the A.W. Spence Band program. Every band member is expected to know the policies and procedures that have been set forth to ensure the success of the band program.

### **A.W. Spence Middle School Band Philosophy**

The goal for each student in the band program is to gain a well-rounded musical experience through education, performance and culture. It is the A.W. Spence Middle School Band Program's belief that all students are capable of learning music and have the ability to achieve greatness when given the opportunity through quality instruction.

It is also important to build unity so that the students will be able to form positive relationships, which in result will help prepare them to live and work in a culturally diverse society. It is the desire of the band program to instill in students the necessary tools that will help the students become successful in music education and be productive citizens through discipline, pride, dedication and responsibility.

## **Beginner Band**

Beginner Band is for individuals that are first year band members of the A.W. Spence Band Department. Beginner band members are separated into individual classes to match their instrument. For example, all flutes will meet together each day. This is the case for each individual instrument or similar group of instruments. This is done in order to ensure as much individual attention to detail is given to these students as they begin to learn a new musical instrument.

Beginning Band students will be required to attend after school rehearsals in order to prepare for our Winter/Spring Concerts and Festivals

***Materials Needed:*** As soon as possible (**Beginner Band Students**)

- Pencils (only allowed in class)
- 1" black binder
- 5 tab dividers (1 set)

**Each Beginner Band member is expected to meet all of the following expectations:**

- ❖ Attend all band classes, rehearsals and sectionals that are required
- ❖ Come to rehearsal focused, prepared and ready to play daily
- ❖ Show **exemplary respect** for all staff and students at all times
- ❖ Follow the director's instructions the first time given
- ❖ To maintain a 70 or higher in every class each reporting period
- ❖ Always represent the A.W.Spence program in a positive manner
- ❖ To always strive to be at your best both musically, academically and behaviorally

***Failure to follow instructions with a positive attitude will result in parental contact, followed by appropriate disciplinary procedures.***

**1<sup>st</sup> infraction: Student warning**

**2<sup>nd</sup> infraction: Student/Teacher Conference**

**3<sup>rd</sup> infraction: Parent communication**

**4<sup>th</sup> infraction: Parent conference**

**5<sup>th</sup> infraction: Removal from Varsity Band (possible removal from band program entirely)**

## **Band Fees**

Each student will be assessed a **NON-REFUNDABLE Band Activity/Instrument Usage Fee of \$30.00**

An instrument usage fee is required for all Dallas Independent School District Band Students. The fees will be placed in the band activity fund to help purchase necessary items in order to ensure that the band has a successful year.

*The due date for the \$30.00 payment is: **Friday, September 12, 2025.** Individuals with financial hardships will have the opportunity to arrange payment installments.*

### **Fundraisers**

Fundraisers initiated by the band program will be allocated for the sole purpose to assist students in need or band department needs.

**Important notice:** Monies raised through fundraising and concerts are never refunded to the student. They will remain in the Student Activity Account for future usage.

### **Academic Eligibility**

As mandated by the Texas UIL, any grade below 70 on a six-week report card will deny any student the right to a competitive performance for a three or six weeks grading period. Grades are very important to the overall academic standing and ability of a student to participate in most events on campus. Please help by periodically checking your child's grades in the Parent Portal.

**Sectionals/Rehearsals:** There will be times when it is necessary to have full band rehearsals after school. A detailed sectional schedule will be sent home to all parents and/or uploaded to the band program social media.

**Band Performance Dates:** All Performances are worth **2 test grades**. Band members are expected to perform. Band is a team effort. The band can only be successful with everyone being responsible to their fellow bandmates. Attendance is required for the ENTIRE CONCERT, not just an individual student's performance.

Any student that fails to perform with their bandmates without an excused absence will receive 2 test grades of zero. Excused absences are considered family emergencies and personal illness. Band members with an excused absence will have the opportunity to make up their grades with a major project.

Performance dates are given plenty in advance to allow parents to make arrangements for their child to attend the required performance.

### **Required Performance Dress Code:**

**Formal Dress:** All black (tops, bottoms, socks, shoes, dresses) no shorts, jeans or tennis shoes

**Informal Dress:** Band shirt, black pants or blue jeans and tennis shoes

- Any student with financial hardship may **always** ask for assistance with performance attire. Students are also able to donate for those who are less than fortunate

### **Suggestions, Ideas and Concerns**

Please contact the band director at any time via phone, e-mail and/or band social media with any concerns or suggestions that you might have. Suggestions will be listened to, considered, and discussed. Ideas are welcomed that will improve the band and the musical educational experience of the students.

Please direct concerns to the band director. If you feel unsatisfied with the results, feel free to pursue the issue with the A.W. Spence Administration. To immediately go to the AWS Administration and/or school district with minor concerns (that could easily be corrected on the school level with the director) could lead to the AWS Band developing an unnecessary negative reputation with the community and leaders of the Dallas Independent School District.

## **BEGINNER BAND STUDENT AGREEMENT**

If I feel that I cannot or will not abide by all of the rules, requirements or guidelines mentioned, I will refuse to sign and request another elective from the counselor and be removed from this band ensemble.***
