Definition of Rural - We define the term 'rural' as a region located on the outskirts. It refers to a small settlement, which is outside the boundaries of a city, commercial or industrial area. It may include countryside areas, villages or hamlets, where there is natural vegetation and open spaces. There is a low density of population in such areas. The primary source of income of the residents is agriculture and animal husbandry. Cottage Industries also form a chief source of income here.

Population - the number of people in a single area.

Industrialisation - the development of industries in a country or region on a wide scale.

Hamlet - a small settlement, generally one smaller than a village.
