**Nutrition program**

- The program is short of funds, approx. \$4-6K shortfall (until the second grant kicks in in January)
- The program typically costs \$9K per month
- We may not be able to have snack during last two weeks of December
- Action: the fundraising team will look into food insecurity grants; Lise will make another ask for donations in the new year; admin also looking into improving online donation system and sending home envelopes

**Language/Graffiti**

- There was an incident of racist anti-Black graffiti in the upstairs boys' bathroom; this is not the first incident of this language this year
- No individual consequences have taken place because not sure who wrote it; the role of an educational institute is to educate, on top of any individual consequences/processes
- The junior division held a "circle" to discuss slurs and their impact, and a survey about where they might be learning these words (youtube, online chats in games, older siblings)
- Actions: ongoing invitation to parents/caregivers to join the equity committee; junior division will do internet safety lessons; council can discuss a workshop on online safety and anti-racism for parents/caregivers to attend; admin will communicate with council about any increasing/worrying trends in language

4. **Financial Update (Jaclyn Pritchard)**

**Budget Discussion**

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- Teacher requests were completed in teams, with a budget of approx. \$65/kid; requests were expected to include field trips, speakers and gift cards
- Total budget requests came in at ~\$26K; current bank total is ~\$15K and fundraising projections amount to ~\$14K
- Approving this budget with all requests could mean entering next year with less than our preferred \$10K cushion in the bank account; assuming this year's fundraising events are on the low end

**Saliva test program (Leslie from Hospital for Sick Children)**

- Burgess has been participating in the saliva testing program for the past three weeks
- <https://www.sickkids.ca/en/care-services/saliva-testing-program/>
- The program was previously only COVID, but now expanded to test for Influenza and RSV
- Saliva kits get dropped off at the school; parents can pick-up/drop-off kits any day before 9:30, in the cooler in the school office
- HSC will have the results ready the next day and families will receive a phone call if there is a positive result; no phone call if negative
- Results are also available through the MyChart web portal
- Parents/caregivers can also participate in the program
- Kits contain full instructions
- Name on test sample must be a legal name that aligns with a valid health card

When to do a test: mild symptoms, runny nose, fever, chills vomiting

There is also an optional research study looking for participants. If tested positive, the hospital will continue to test you for 10 days to help track the viral load (how long the virus lasts) and the infectious rate after symptoms subside

Random testing: every week a certain number of classrooms are selected and given the option of doing the kits to support with the research. All optional.
