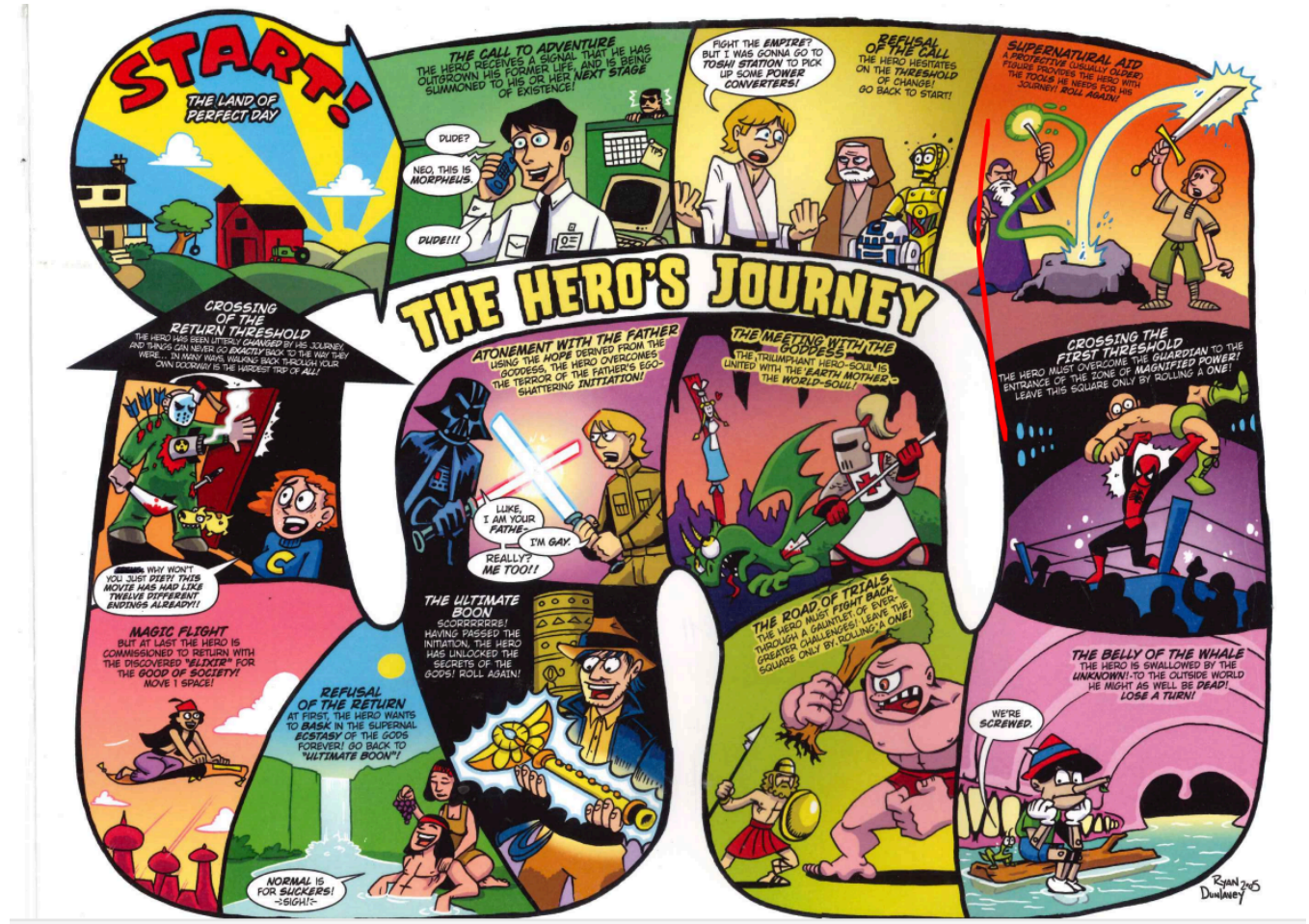

Deontology determines the rightness or wrongness of an action based on whether it adheres to a set of rules or duties, rather than its consequences

Virtue ethics- focuses on an individual's character and virtues rather on duties or consequences, as a basis for moral action
