Musically, we will learn how to play as a band, how to lead songs and sing background and how to prepare our hearts before ever stepping foot on a stage, playing an instrument, or singing into a microphone. We will also have a couple of field trips to attend local worship nights in Ventura County and Los Angeles County, giving the students an opportunity to apply what we're learning in a Spirit-filled, worshipful setting.
