Service Engagement Internship

The Service Engagement Internship (SEI) - Powered by Repair the World and Hillel International (formerly known as the Repair Campus Corps Program) **supports student interns at Hillels around the world to engage their peers in volunteering, civic engagement, and social change work.**

Participating Interns receive:

- \$500 stipend per intern (North America)
- Virtual Education and training:
 - Leading effective volunteer programs
 - An issue area of your choice (eg: climate and environmentalism, food justice, education justice, etc...)
- Access to \$500 program dollars per intern through your local Hillel
- A community of peers around the world

Requirements:

Each intern must:

- Volunteer 10 times.
- Engage at least 25 additional students, each of whom will volunteer at least once.
- Attend an orientation session (options in September or October) and mid-year training (January).
- Participate in a local or national cohort learning experience depending on the number of interns on your campus and your supervisor's plan.
- Regularly check in with your supervisor.
