



My Future Fund Program Release of Information

My Future Fund is a Washtenaw Intermediate School District (WISD) program that provides eligible students with free money and financial education to plan and save for college and career training. As part of the program, students will automatically receive a My Future Fund Account which includes a free \$25 deposit.

Keeping your family's information secure and confidential is important to us, therefore, the My Future Fund program needs your authorization to access student/family information. My Future Fund Use of Student/Family Information

The My Future Fund Program will access student/family information for the following:

Program Communications & Administration

My Future Fund will use the information provided in a student's education record and on this form to update your child's My Future Fund record and the My Future Fund family portal.

- This information includes student date of birth, grade level, mailing address, parent/guardian email and telephone number.
- The My Future Fund program will use this information to send electronic and mailed communications and keep the student's My Future Fund records up to date for each year they are enrolled in the program.

Determining Eligibility for Future Deposits

My Future Fund may access a student's education record to determine eligibility for additional deposits.

- With additional funding, there may be the opportunity to provide future deposits related to specific criteria found in the educational record. Information in the education record that My Future Fund might access includes, but is not limited to, grade levels, attendance, homelessness or English learner.
- My Future Fund may also check whether a student has or is participating in the National School Lunch program to determine eligibility for certain deposits, including a one-time \$475 deposit related to pandemic relief. (Note: not signing this form will not affect eligibility of participation in the National School Lunch program.)
- If a student is found to meet the criteria for a particular deposit, the amount will be automatically allocated to the student's My Future Fund Account. The specific eligibility criteria for each deposit will be included on the My Future Fund website (myfuturefund.org) or can be obtained by contacting the My Future Fund program.
