Intro

The focus of this project is on the Black [fraternal orders](#) you find at colleges and universities – the fraternities and sororities (also called academic orders) – and those you find outside of these institutions, such as Prince Hall Freemasonry and the Order of the Eastern Star. Through my years of research on various topics, I ran into Freemasonry again and again so was already familiar with the secrets of Freemasonry before starting on this project. But what I didn't know, and what shocked me to the core, was the truth about Black fraternities and sororities. I am truly disturbed, angered, and absolutely disgusted by what I found. ... tricking people into making covenants with spirits; tricking people into worshipping spirits; tricking people into getting possessed; tricking people into selling their soul – this, and more, is what they're doing. You'll see. Note: Prince Hall Freemasonry is exposed through exposing Freemasonry in *The Masonic Connection*.

Quick Facts

- Greek gods. I think even atheists know that the God of the Bible is vehemently opposed to a person bowing down to, worshipping, vowing to, presenting an offering to, or singing a song to a Greek god.

- The reverence that is given to the founders in most, if not all, Greek organizations amounts to veneration of the dead. This is what you see in ancestor worship. And in these Greek orgs it's usually done in a way that treats the founder(s) as some sort of god(s). This is a problem, and not just in regards to idolatry. The way it is done, and the fact that it's being done to spirits (dead people) means it's being directed toward the spirit realm. This means they are initiating contact with the spirit realm, which gives a spirit(s) the right to enter the environment or person. This is not speculation. This is a fact. This is a law. A prime example of this can be seen with a Ouija Board. People seeing words spelled out and having questions answered may not always be spiritually related, but real spiritual phenomena can occur. But it's not the board that is special. It's not the board itself that has power. It's the design and purpose of the board that brings together your intent and an action taken toward initiating contact. That's the trigger. And that's when things can happen.

- "God" and "Lord" are actually titles, not proper names. When secret societies use these titles, or similar ones, even in the presence of the Bible or in conjunction with Bible verses, they're not actually referring to the God of the Bible. In most cases you would need to rise higher within the organization to discover this.

- Most people who join these Greek organizations are not aware of what it is they're truly doing. It's similar to how most people who join Freemasonry don't truly know what they have said or done when they joined, and have no idea of what the organization is truly about. This is especially true for those who joined

decades ago when there was no internet. How much grace is given to such a person is up to God, and is dealt with on an individual basis. But if it's brought to their attention that they may have transgressed by joining, and they don't go look into it to see if this is so, that's when grace will dry up.

- Before the 2000's it was more widely preached to Black youth seeking to attend college that joining a Greek org in college would act as a booster for the obtainment of success in life. And of the Blacks who did join, for nearly all of them, this was the reason they joined. There wasn't some sinister intent, and they definitely didn't see themselves as being a part of some grand conspiracy, as some internet users today exclaim. Many are literally just trying to look good on paper for their future employers, or be helped somewhere down the line by a brother or sister of the org.

- The members try to claim things, while non-members try to blame things. What I mean by that is that whenever an important person or group of people of the past were members of a Greek org, members today will try to claim that the important things done by the person or people were due to their affiliation with the Greek org. As if they weren't already special before joining the org; and as if the org made them who they were ("They came out of..."). Non-members will point to a person or people's affiliation with a Greek org as the only evidence needed to prove that they were a part of a conspiracy.

- It is very likely that if you were to look deeper at the history and associates connected to the founders and ideologies of these Black Greek organizations you would find non-Blacks and an actual conspiracy.

- "All fraternities and sororities are demonic!" Every single one? There are a very large number of these organizations in existence today. And when it comes to the Black orgs, there are more than just the nine popular ones. Have you looked at all of their initiations, ceremonies, songs, and the like to be able to make such a statement?

- If you are going to join a fraternity or sorority (or any group) you have to ensure that God will not be displeased with your decision, and that you are not

transgressing by doing so. You also have to ensure that God will not be displeased and that you are not transgressing if you undergo an initiation or hazing, state words or sing a song, enter a covenant/contract, or bow before an object. [Or whatever else is involved.] In other words, His approval and your walk should take priority over everything you are asked to do and say, or not do or say. But there would have to be a very rare circumstance for you to bow before an object in such a setting and not be seen as doing something extremely wrong in God's eyes.

- One overlooked issue associated with joining fraternal orders, especially those where secrecy is a major component, is being unaware of the true spiritual state, beliefs and practices of the head(s) of the order.

- Hazing. You want something so badly that you're willing to go through "this," and put up with "that." If this is the case, and you're not forced, then how can you not share in the blame, or be entirely to blame, for the consequences? And unless the hazing process consists of something unrighteous, I don't see it being against God. But ... there may be, most likely will be, an issue down the line when He looks for and/or requests the same perseverance and sacrifice from you. And it's highly likely that you will not deliver. And that's going to be a problem.

The Borrowed Elements of BGLOs

What you're going to see and hear in the next section (*The Divine Nine*) is already shocking enough, but adding the information in this section will take it to the next level. The information in this section will give you the eyes to see and ears to hear what some of these organizations are actually engaging in, and tricking others to engage in. And you may have already seen some renouncement videos and heard some statements made by former members, but trust me, gaining this knowledge first and then watching the videos will totally expose the truth of what these orgs are pushing without a doubt. I've included some of the similarities mentioned in the videos (only some) here in this section after the learning portion just to show you a little bit. Just keep reading; you'll see.

“The ancient Greeks did not have a word for 'religion' in the modern sense. Likewise, no Greek writer is known to have classified either the gods or the cult practices into separate 'religions'. Instead, for example, Herodotus speaks of the Hellenes as having ‘common shrines of the gods and sacrifices, and the same kinds of customs’. Most ancient Greeks recognized the [twelve major Olympian gods and goddesses](#)—[Zeus](#), [Hera](#), [Poseidon](#), [Demeter](#), [Athena](#), [Ares](#), [Aphrodite](#), [Apollo](#), [Artemis](#), [Hephaestus](#), [Hermes](#), and either [Hestia](#) or [Dionysus](#)— ... Greek ceremonies and rituals were mainly performed at altars, which were never inside temples, but often just outside, or standing by themselves somewhere. These were typically devoted to one or a few gods, and supported a statue of the particular deity. Votive deposits were left at the altar, such as food, drinks, as well as precious objects. Sometimes animal sacrifices were performed here, with most of the flesh taken for eating and the offal burnt as an offering to the gods. Libations, often of wine, would be offered to the gods as well, not only at shrines, but also in everyday life, such as during a symposium.”

“**Hellenism** (Greek: Ἑλληνισμός)^[a] is the modern pluralistic religion practiced in Greece and around the world by several communities derived from Ancient Greek beliefs, mythology, and rituals from Classical antiquity through and up to today. It is a system of thought and spirituality with a shared culture and values, and common ritualistic, linguistic, and literary tradition. More broadly, Hellenism centers itself on the worship of [Hellenic deities](#), namely the [twelve Olympians](#).^[1] Greeks who identify their religion and way of life with Hellenism are commonly referred to as Εθνικοί Έλληνες (ethnic Hellenes). Non-Greek devotees of the Greek gods who embody Hellenic ideals are commonly referred to as Hellenists. Hellenism is sometimes referred to as a Pagan religion; this classification is also at times used as a pejorative for Greeks.”

“**Necromancy** (/ˈnekərəmænsi/) is the practice of magic involving communication with the dead by summoning their spirits as apparitions or visions for the purpose of divination; imparting the means to foretell future events and discover hidden knowledge. Sometimes categorized under *death magic*, the term is occasionally also used in a more general sense to refer to black magic or witchcraft as a whole. ... Early necromancy was related to – and most likely evolved from – forms of [shamanism](#) or prehistoric ritual magic that calls upon spirits such as the ghosts of deceased forebears. Classical necromancers addressed the dead in ‘a mixture of high-pitch squeaking and low droning’, comparable to the trance-state mutterings

of shamans. ... Rituals could be quite elaborate, involving [magic circles](#), [wands](#), [talismans](#), and [incantations](#). The necromancer might also surround himself with morbid aspects of death, which often included wearing the deceased's clothing and consuming foods that symbolized lifelessness and decay such as unleavened black bread and unfermented grape juice. ... These ceremonies could carry on for hours, days, or even weeks, leading up to the eventual summoning of spirits. ... The act of performing medieval necromancy usually involved magic circles, conjurations, and sacrifices such as those shown in the [Munich Manual of Demonic Magic](#):

- Circles were usually traced on the ground, though cloth and parchment were sometimes used. Various objects, shapes, symbols, and letters may be drawn or placed within that represent a mixture of Christian and occult ideas. Circles were usually believed to empower and protect what was contained within, including protecting the necromancer from the conjured demons. A text known as the Heptameron explain the function of the circle thusly: ‘But because the greatest power is attributed to the Circles; (For they are certain fortresses to defend the operators safe from the evil Spirits;)...’
- Conjunction is the method of communicating with the demons to have them enter the physical world. It usually employs the power of special words and stances to call out the demons and often incorporated the use of Christian prayers or biblical verses. These conjurations may be repeated in succession or repeated to different directions until the summoning is complete.
- Sacrifice was the payment for summoning; though it may involve the flesh of a human being or animal, it could sometimes be as simple as offering a certain object. Instructions for obtaining these items were usually specific. The time, location, and method of gathering items for sacrifice could also play an important role in the ritual.”

“A ritual circle (or magic circle) is a circle of space marked out by practitioners of many branches of witchcraft and ritual magic, either to contain energy and form a sacred space, or as a form of magical protection, or both. It may be marked physically (drawn in salt or chalk, for example) or merely visualised. ... As the members of the coven stand within a circle, holding hands (or sometimes dancing, drumming, chanting or performing various other ritual gestures) and focussing on a single point above and in the centre of the circle, they can raise energy in a ‘cone of power’ with the circle forming its base.”

“When most people think of a group of witches, the word that immediately springs to mind is **coven**. This is arguably the most widely recognized and historically significant term. Think of the classic image: a circle of witches, perhaps under the moonlight, engaged in ritual and shared practice. ... Another term you'll frequently encounter is **circle**. This term is often used more broadly than coven and can refer to any group of witches coming together for a specific purpose or ritual. It emphasizes the circular arrangement, which is deeply symbolic in many spiritual

practices, representing unity, completeness, and the cyclical nature of life.”

“Throughout the history of witchcraft, the four elements of Earth, Air, Fire and Water have been used as powerful tools for spiritual practitioners, literally since the beginning of times. In modern witchcraft traditions you can find them predominantly in Wicca rituals, but working with them is, of course, not exclusive to wiccans. The elements, which are the building blocks of nature, are believed to have transformative properties when used in magical practice. Each element has its own unique characteristics and is associated with different spells, rituals, and energies. ... Earth is the element of stability and strength, and it is associated with the physical body, the cycles of life and death, and the material world. ... Air is the element of communication and intellect, and it is associated with the mind, communication, and knowledge. ... Fire is the element of passion and transformation, and it is associated with the will, power, and transformation. ... Water is the element of emotion and intuition, and it is associated with the emotions, intuition, and the subconscious.”

“The four elements, earth, air, fire, and water, are physical materials and energies that comprise the world around us. If you don't already work with the four elements in your practice, you've likely heard of them because they're rather tricky to avoid as so many spiritual practices refer to them in some way. ... One of the first written examples of the four elements comes from the Greek philosopher Empedocles in the fifth century BCE. Empedocles refers to them as the four roots and assigns each element or ‘root’ to a Greek God or Goddess as follows, Hera

with earth, Zeus with air, Aidoneus with fire, and Nestis with water (though there is some debate over this, this is the consensus.) The Gods and Goddesses Empedocles associated with each element is less important (to me) than the fact that he did associate them with Gods and Goddesses. Because Empedocles gave these elements spiritual significance by corresponding each with a God or Goddess, it indicates that he viewed them as having a deeper meaning than mere elements on a periodic table.”

“One of the simplest ways to start an earth-based spiritual practice is through connecting with the natural elements. This is something that is so foundational to my own practice that I often forget to share about it. Yet I know a lot of women are just starting out with finding their way into elemental magic. Do you know the popular chant that goes ‘Earth, my body. Water, my blood. Air, my breath and Fire my spirit’? It’s a beautiful chant that reminds us that we are made of the same elements as nature. Many of my suggestions involve being in nature and working with altars. I recognize that creating altars isn’t everyone’s path so I don’t want anyone thinking they’re not a ‘proper witch’ because they don’t have an altar. This is a way that we can cut ourselves down or think that we’re not doing enough or not being enough. ... And so let’s begin with Earth. Earth, my body. The Earth element is associated with our physical bodies. ... Air, my breath. Air is associated with the mind – the mental realm of thoughts. ... Water, my blood. The element of water connects us to our emotions, our emotional body. ... Fire, my spirit. For most women starting out on any kind of ‘witchy’ path, candle magic or fire rituals seem to be the most common. Fire connects us to our creativity. It’s our passion, our willpower.”

“So what makes a candle transform from the mundane to the magical? It’s the **intent**. What separates candle magic from regular candle-lighting is the act of setting an intention. In other words, by writing a spell. And with this spell, you’re doing magic. ... An intention, in the context of magic, is a specific statement made as if it has already happened. Instead of writing *I will improve my diet*, you might write something in the past tense that’s more specific to your situation, like *After two weeks, I will have eaten the recommended amount of fruits and vegetables, each day, every day, of those two weeks*. See how more impactful the second statement is? ... There is magic everywhere. So the objects you use each contribute meaning to your spell that you can then incorporate into your intention. Candle dressing is the act of putting whatever you want directly on your candle: herbs, oil, or crystals to start. This act helps to further define your intention by giving your mind something to latch onto.”

“Candle magic is one of the simplest forms of magick. Candles represent the intense element of Fire and wand energy. In rituals, they are action-oriented and can be used to set something in motion or call in an energy. To help you set and focus on your intention, choosing the right candle color can help as each has a different spiritual meaning. ... Candle magic is a type of manifestation ritual that is centered around the use of candles to create a desired outcome in a ritual or spell. Those who follow many different spiritual paths use candle magic, including witches. We all know the element of Fire has a powerful, transformative effect, which is one reason so many witches use candle magic. It’s relatively simple, direct, and (usually) fast. Another is that some believe you can use candle magic to connect with deities, guides, and the spirit realm. If you don’t think you’ve ever performed candle magick, think back to your last birthday. When you wished on the candles flickering on your birthday cake then blew them out, that was a spell. You were doing magic! The ritual of blowing out birthday candles actually goes back to the Ancient Greeks. For birthdays, they baked Full Moon cakes in honor of the goddess Artemis and then lit them with candles so they would reflect like the Moon.”

“There are probably ten zillion candle spells out there, and a dozen good resources on candle spellcraft. Why not, I thought, make a step-by-step cheat sheet on crafting a spell candle for magical use? So, without further ado, here’s my process for candle magic: 1. Choose your Candle. Depending on the spell or the intent, you’ll want to select a color of candle appropriate to your use. Look up the color correspondence for your spell, such as green for prosperity or pink for love, if you need to. ... 2. Mark it Well. Here’s where you inscribe your candle with intent. A simple way to do this is to look up the runes pertaining to your intent, then scratching them into your candle. You can also draw them on in color with a good marker or a natural paint such as ground juniper berries. Some Witches swear by a hot needle. If runes aren’t your thing, you can write in words, use a sigil, or any other demarcation you like. 3. Anoint your Candle. ... 4. Make your Spell. This is my favorite part! Gather any correspondences appropriate to your spell, and arrange them in any way you see fit around the candle. Many Witches like to create a decorative circle. Common items of correspondence you can use in your spell are tarot cards (pick one of the Major Arcana, or perhaps a Court card, that represents your intent), corresponding crystals, corresponding herbs, and corresponding flowers and plants. You can, of course, use any symbol pertaining to your cause that you like! There are several tables, and, of course, searchable resources that you can go through to find the right correspondences, such as the herbs for Athena or the right crystals for protection magic. Then - light your candle at the right magickal time, focus your intent, and enjoy your spellcasting. Simple as that!”

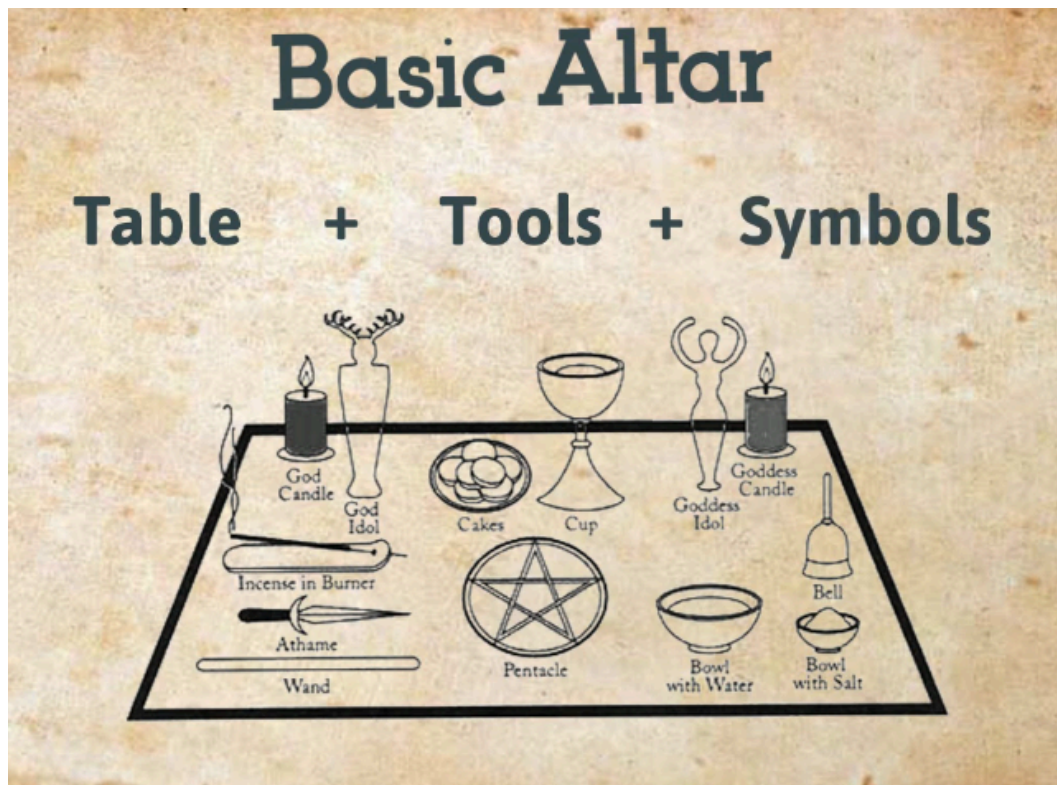
- 0:32 – “When casting spells, we use the word ‘altar’ to talk about our work table. Actually, it could be any flat surface and even just a mat on the floor. Your altar will be the focal point of your spells or rituals, and it is where most ritual actions and Magical works will be performed. Setting up a basic altar is quite simple, usually it’s just a table where you will place the tools you are about to use and any symbols depicting your beliefs. The first rule of your pagan altar is that anything goes.”

- 1:51 – “No matter what kind of altar you are creating, it is advisable to cover its surface with a piece of cloth that will act both as an ornament and as protection from liquids, scratching, and wax drippings. Go shopping for an altar cloth and if you see any that you like and have some symbols on it, ask about their meanings. Some witches like to change their altar cloth according to the type of ritual they are doing, or following the Wheel of the Year, having a different one for each season and each pagan holiday. If you’re on a budget, simply use any piece of cloth that you have at home.”

- 2:27 – “If you are an eclectic practitioner and feel connected to Christianity, Buddhism, Hinduism or anything other spiritual traditions, you can add images or figures that symbolize your beliefs and remind you of who you are. If you are devoted to a specific deity, you could add a statue or drawing of them on your altar.”

- 3:08 – “If you plan to work with Candle Magic, you’ll need at least one candle holder.”

The Sorority Seal

The Official Seal of the Sorority is a circular engraving with "Delta Sigma Theta – Grand Chapter" surrounding the Crest. Under the Crest is the founding year, "1913." The Grand Chapter was incorporated in 1930.

The Sorority Crest

The Sorority Crest is the official Coat of Arms. It was designed by Soror F. Ailene Marks and Soror Jeannette Triplett Jones, 6th National President, both of Lambda Chapter. It was authorized in 1934 by the National Executive Committee. The official Crest is crimson and cream. The Crest is a composite idea expressing graphically the Sorority's public motto: "Intelligence is the Torch of Wisdom." Minerva (Pallas Athena), the Goddess of Wisdom, is atop the shield which bears the torch, the sword, the staff and the three Greek letters Δ (Delta) Σ (Sigma) Θ (Theta). The sword, representing truth, is a part of Minerva's symbolism. The staff symbolizes intelligent leadership. The laurel wreath is the symbol of achievement as used by the Greeks.

The Sorority Crest must be used in good taste. (Good taste is a reflection of the style and appreciation of beauty that satisfies the Sorority's accepted social and aesthetic standards).

Delta's National Headquarters staff may approve the use of the Crest by vendors upon inspection of the final product, to verify its compliance with Delta's policies and standards. The use of the Crest, symbols and Greek letters are not approved or appropriate for the lining in a casket, on a tombstone, on a funeral program or in an obituary section of the newspaper.

The Sorority Emblem

The Sorority emblem is the Goddess Minerva (Pallas Athena), Goddess of Wisdom.

The Sorority Colors

Official Sorority Colors

Crimson and cream are the official colors of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated. For practical purposes, the colors red and white are the only recognized substitutes for the official colors.

THE MINERVA CIRCLE

The planning, chapter training and implementation of all intake activities, including the induction and initiation of new members into Delta Sigma Theta, is vested in a committee of active members designated as the Minerva Circle.

It is fitting that the attributes associated with Minerva, the goddess of wisdom, be influential in the minds and spirits of these sorors as they plan and execute their duties. The Minerva Circle is elected to carry out the Sorority's most sacred trust, "The induction of new members into Delta Sigma Theta is the sorority's most sacred trust." The sorors who comprise the Minerva Circle have a major responsibility. It should be recognized as such by the chapter with appropriate appreciation and esteem. Only those sorors who have completed a Membership Intake Workshop by a certified membership intake trainer are eligible to be elected to serve on the Minerva Circle. Collegiate sorors must have the minimum cumulative GPA required for membership in chapters as verified by the chapter advisor in order to be eligible to be elected as a member of the Minerva Circle.

THE MINERVA CIRCLE OF IDENTITY

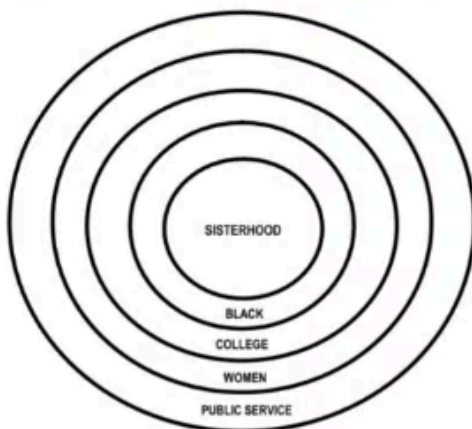

Figure 1 - Illustrates a circle which places Sisterhood at the very core of a corporate identity, with other facets of identity moving further from the core, but all a holistic unit bound in the Minerva Circle.

The Sorority is founded on Christian principles. The Core Identity of the Minerva Circle is Sisterhood, where a deliberate centering of priority identities is intentionally established.

Minerva Circle: a committee of active members.

(Each Candidate signs the Bond and stands. She is pinned by a Soror and given a lighted candle/penlight by the Leader of the Minerva Circle. The Pyramids are seated after the last Pyramid returns to her place.)

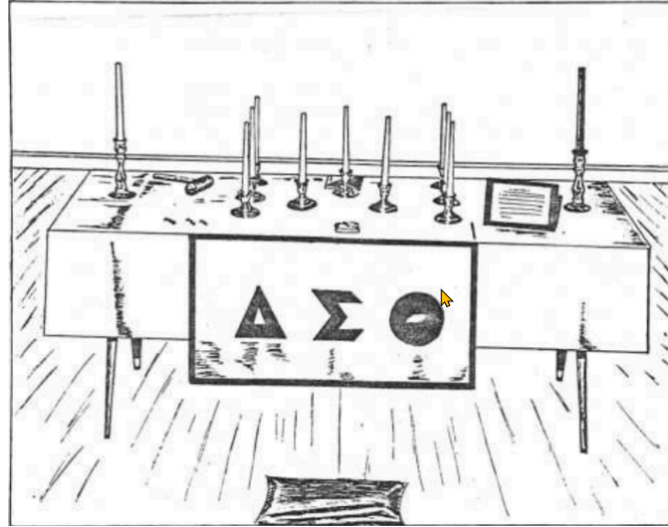

It is not generally known that God is dead serious, EXTREMELY SERIOUS, when it comes to vows/your word/covenants/contracts. People take it lightly, while He is out-of-this-world extreme with it. There is another issue. At the very least, after breaking the contract you will have lied and become a liar at that moment (even though the overall act is toward righteousness). And that sin needs to be atoned for (through the new covenant method of atonement). In addition to lying, you will have also become a covenant-breaker, which is definitely not good. And that sin needs to be atoned for (through the new covenant method of atonement). These are just the facts.

I saw a video where a guy brought up Leviticus 5:4-5 and correctly stated how people who joined these organizations are guilty when they realize their sin. But I want to add to that just in case you believe these verses are saying that you can just confess your sins and everything will be alright. These verses are talking about a person who utters an oath recklessly without knowing. But were all of your oaths/vows like this? Or did you make vows during, and as a part of, an official ceremony, like a wedding? If so, that's not the same, unless there were circumstances that made it the same. As stated, each person's situation is different. Did you hear what was said? Did they ask you if you heard or agreed? Factors such as these may change how binding your oath is.

When it's all said and done, it may be that you end up separated but not legally (in God's eyes) divorced from the person, organization or spirit you vowed to.

Prescription

1. Get rid of all of the paraphernalia you have.
2. Renounce, contacting the organization and asking for an official release. Follow up.
3. Approach God humbly and shamefully, and ask (with emotion and deep down from the heart ... like a person who's done something horribly wrong) for forgiveness in the name of Jesus (or whatever name you call the sacrificial lamb ...

Yahshua, Yahusha, etc.) for [name off the things you did wrong, including lying and not honoring vows and covenants].

4. Ask to be released from all vows and covenants made in association with the organization, including, but not limited to, those made with people and spirits.

[You can try this, but this is not guaranteed to work/be done on your behalf.]

5. Explain yourself – why you did it, and shouldn't have done it.

6. Ask for protection from harm to your physical and spiritual self, your life/the life you live, and all others, related or not, who can potentially be impacted by what you've done.

7. Depending on what you may have said and done at your particular organization, you may also want to consider going through a spiritual deliverance, performed by people who are truly experienced in this area (not just someone you think seems cool or is popular on social media).

Do that, and as long as your intentions are righteous, and you're someone who is in good standing with God, someone who's prayers He would even answer, you'll be fine.

FYI: Of course He loves the fact that you see your wrong and are trying to correct it, and that's taken into consideration when He makes His decisions.





A Deeper Look at the Problem

From the News interview to Lecrae to Judge Joe Brown, these people just proved what one of the major problems is – allegiance. When their org, this over here, says or does something wrong against God, that over there, what do they do? They choose the org. They lie and deceive for their org. And when their org, this over here, says or does something harmful to Black people, that over there, what do you think they'll do? The same. It's similar to Democrats putting the party over Blacks – let the right circumstance come about, like immigration/immigrants, and you'll see where their heart truly lies. It's with the party. So basically you're just waiting for the right moment to be stabbed in the back by these people.

Most Blacks are concerned about atheists and followers of other religions, but atheists and followers of other religions don't take oaths/vows to orgs. Unbeknownst to them they may be yoked spiritually, but they are not doing an official marriage ceremony with vows that bind them to that organization stronger than anything else, or that prioritize the org over everything else. The people that do the latter are in another league. True or false, they would be angrier at a person who disrespected their org than a person who did the same to God, His son, the Bible, or Black people? That's a problem.

Black celebrities are under contracts or other circumstances, like fear, that act as puppet strings attached to different parts of their body. This renders them to a status of a robot that takes and carries out orders from the Jewish and non-Jewish Whites in power above them. For this reason, and others, I tell people all the time that Black celebrities are really outsiders who should never be trusted (House Negroes). But when you look at it, who else is in the very same position as these sellout Black celebrities? It's these members of fraternal orders (on and off campus). For example, in secret societies like Freemasonry, membership is composed of regular people from all walks of life; from those who work a 9-5 to

those in high-ranking government and corporate positions. These people can be called on at any time to make a decision the higher-ups want made. It's a hidden network, similar to hidden communication wires, they can work through to accomplish their desires. When they need a judge to make a certain decision, they contact him/her. When they need a doctor to make a certain decision, they contact him/her. Think of the Black people who are members of fraternal orders. These people are among us like FBI informants or sleeper cells. So what happens when they get "activated"/called on?

[This same type of network exists in the spiritual realm, made up of spirits loyal to the fallen angels the Elite and some practitioners of magic deal with; spirits dwelling in, attached to and assigned to regular everyday people. This is a part of what you might call Satan's spiritual kingdom, and it is how the law of attraction works. In the 1st century the Holy Spirit enabled believers to cast out these spirits, destroying his kingdom. Fast forward to recent times and the powers-that-be created the New Age Movement as a Christian replacement and way to trick people into letting spirits into themselves and their environment, mostly through meditation. This is rebuilding Satan's kingdom. And now we see these fraternal orders have been tricking people into doing the same thing for even longer.]

And who are the people who will be "activating" them/giving them orders to carry out? It's their higher-ups. When it comes to fraternal orders that have levels like Freemasonry, most members stay in the lower levels, but above that, in the higher levels, is where things get, what most would call, Satanic. But it's these people in these higher levels who will be contacting the members in the lower levels and having them do their will, or someone else's will. And yet you believe this is not a big deal?

"Now more than a century old, Black Greek Letter Organizations – fraternities – have more than 800,000 members. But are such organizations an asset or do they work against African American culture? Ali Chambers argues that rather than unifying the Black community against the effects of racial prejudice, they have merely become a vehicle for Blacks to assimilate into White culture and society, and a means to create a self-perpetuating Black oligarchy." factories. Many of these Blacks in these orgs, and at HBCUs in general, are the types of Blacks who only associate with other Blacks who are educated and/or wealthy. And since they associate with other Blacks, though only from specific segments of the Black population, they actually believe themselves to be pro-Black. And they go off and live their best life instead of helping the rest of Blacks, who are poor and undereducated. This is why the rest of us don't benefit. Now think about this: How crazy is it that the brightest of Blacks are sucked into these groups, plucked out from among the rest of us, made to take oaths, and made to take orders of higher-ups who are most likely controlled by non-Blacks? This is clearly a setup.

Every non-Greek Black organization that portrays itself as being pro-Black has been turned into a tool that gives the illusion that we have representation and something of our own – the N.A.A.C.P., Congressional Black Caucus, the National Urban League, B.E.T., Essence, etc. And this was all done intentionally while you slept (consumed music, TV, Netflix...). So, why wouldn't it be the same with these fraternal orders (and HBCUs)? I happened to look on the website of the National Pan-Hellenic Council again and noticed that it stated “Trusted Partnerships & Affiliations You Can Count On.” And whose logos did I see? The N.A.A.C.P., the National Urban League, and the Congressional Black Caucus.

Joshua 7:10-15

¹⁰ The Lord said to Joshua, “Get up! Why have you fallen on your face? ¹¹ Israel has sinned; they have transgressed my covenant that I commanded them; they have taken some of the devoted things; they have stolen and lied and put them among their own belongings. ¹² Therefore the people of Israel cannot stand before their enemies. They turn their backs before their enemies, because they have become

devoted for destruction.^[a] I will be with you no more, unless you destroy the devoted things from among you. ¹³ Get up! Consecrate the people and say, ‘Consecrate yourselves for tomorrow; for thus says the Lord, God of Israel, “There are devoted things in your midst, O Israel. You cannot stand before your enemies until you take away the devoted things from among you.” ¹⁴ In the morning therefore you shall be brought near by your tribes. And the tribe that the Lord takes by lot shall come near by clans. And the clan that the Lord takes shall come near by households. And the household that the Lord takes shall come near man by man. ¹⁵ And he who is taken with the devoted things shall be burned with fire, he and all that he has, because he has transgressed the covenant of the Lord, and because he has done an outrageous thing in Israel.”’

“... And He brought them out that He might bring them in—and He made them the executioners of His wrath against the idolaters. They must have no other gods but Him, and they must not treat the things that had been defiled by association with idolatry as their own spoil. The words which specially apply to this case are to be found in [Deuteronomy 7:25-26](#) : ‘The graven images of their gods shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire (see [Joshua 7:21](#)) the silver or gold that is on them. . . Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it.’ The whole spoil of Canaan was not so treated; but concerning that of Jericho there had been express orders, possibly because the city was especially defiled with idolatry. God had proclaimed it abomination. It was ahêrem—devoted or accursed—and no Israelite was to appropriate any of it, under penalty of becoming chêrem himself, and making his household chêrem. The children of Israel couldn't stand before their enemies or move forward because there were things already devoted to utter destruction in their midst – things that were set apart and designated as being off-limits. In this fraternal order situation we're looking at, you would be correct in applying this to idols or maybe even paraphernalia, but it actually goes further than that because it is also true of the people themselves – the people who have engaged in witchcraft and taken vows to gods or fraternal orders dedicated to gods. There are *cherem* people in your midst and you cannot move forward until you remove them, or they are removed. So, either you're going to have to do something about it, or you'll be watching these people get separated from you, probably through mass death since America's judgment is coming.

“Most fraternities and sororities are secret societies. While the identity of members or officers is rarely concealed, fraternities and sororities initiate members following the pledge period through sometimes elaborate private rituals, frequently drawn or adopted from Masonic ritual practice or that of the Greek mysteries. After an initiation ritual, the organization's secret motto, secret purpose, and secret identification signs, such as handshakes and passwords, are usually revealed to its new members. Some fraternities also teach initiates an identity search device used to confirm fellow fraternity members. Julian Hawthorne, the son of Nathaniel Hawthorne, wrote in his posthumously published Memoirs of his initiation into Delta Kappa Epsilon: ‘I was initiated into a college secret society—a couple of hours of grotesque and good-humored rodomontade and horseplay, in which I cooperated as in a kind of pleasant nightmare, confident, even when branded with a red-hot iron or doused head-over-heels in boiling oil, that it would come out all right. The neophyte is effectively blindfolded during the proceedings, and at last, still sightless, I was led down flights of steps into a silent crypt and helped into a coffin, where I was to stay until the Resurrection... Thus it was that just as my father passed from this earth, I was lying in a coffin during my initiation into Delta Kappa Epsilon.’ Meetings and rituals are sometimes conducted in what is known as a chapter room located inside the fraternity's house. Entry into chapter rooms is often prohibited to all but the initiated. In one extreme case, the response of firefighters to a blaze signaled by an automated alarm at the Sigma Phi chapter house at the University of Wisconsin in 2003 was hampered in part because fraternity members refused to disclose to emergency responders the location of the hidden chapter room, where the conflagration had erupted. ... Critics of Greek-letter organizations assert that they create a culture of nepotism in later life,

while supporters have applauded them for creating networking opportunities for members after graduation. A 2013 report by Bloomberg found that fraternity connections are influential in obtaining lucrative employment positions at top Wall Street brokerages. According to the report, recent graduates have been known to exchange the secret handshakes of their fraternities with executives whom they know are also members to obtain access to competitive appointments.”

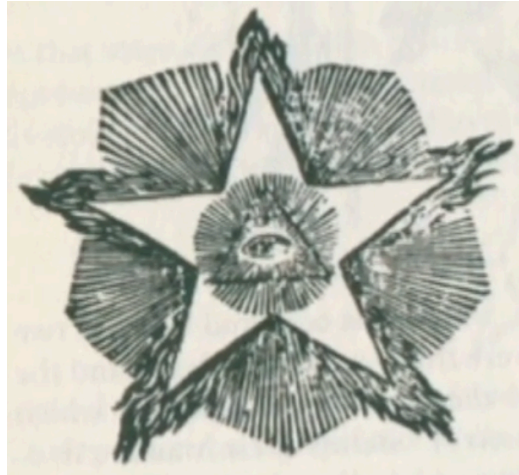

- 29:21 - 29:37 – “Masons teach that at the center of every Masonic lodge there’s a five-pointed star right underneath the altar upon which the candidate is obligated. But the thing is, what they don’t tell you is that five-pointed star represents Sirius, which is regarded as a satanic symbol.”

- 29:40 – “There is perhaps no symbol that evokes occult suspicion like the figure of the pentagram, which from ancient times was associated with the Dog Star Sirius. Masonic philosopher Albert Pike wrote that ‘Sirius still glitters in our lodges as the Blazing Star.’ ‘The Blazing Star’ is an ancient Gnostic term for Sirius, and as shown here, is symbolized in freemasonry by the five-pointed star or pentagram. According to Pike, this symbol in Masonry dates back to the pentalpha of the Greek philosopher Pythagoras. The pentalpha gets its name for the five alphas, or Greek letter a’s, which make up its composition. Typically, in Freemasonry you see the five-pointed star with the nose point down. Now there’s even a division in Masonry which considers this the evil side of Freemasonry as opposed to the non-evil side. For example, Freemasonic lodges in New York do not use the nose side down star, they turn it around so the nose is pointing up. And they consider that a good variety of Freemasonry.”

- 31:34 – “Because Sirius is said to arise in the east, it also became known as the Eastern Star. To the Egyptians, Sirius was identified with the dog god Anubis, which is where the name Dog Star comes from. Anubis was said to have guarded the gates of death, and was the protector of mysteries. Meanwhile, the Romans recognized Sirius as Janitor Lethaeus, or ‘the keeper of hell.’”

- 33:42 - 34:46 – “According to occult philosophers, the light which illuminates the eye comes not from the sun but from the Dog Star, Sirius; as is demonstrated by this illustration of the blazing star of Masonry centered by an all-seeing eye. ... Notice this image with the sun on one side and the moon on the other while the all-seeing eye sits in between with light blazing behind it. Pike writes that “The Sun and Moon ... represent the two grand principles ... the male and the female ... both shed their light upon their offspring, the Blazing Star, or Horus”



- 2:28:09 – “The use of that is actually deceptive”

- 2:32:52 – “Meanwhile, placing a goat's head in the center of it is most often blamed on 19th century French occultist Eliphas Levi.” Though blamed, he might not have been the first. See [Sigil of Baphomet](#).

- 2:33:26 - 2:33:48 – “His writings inspired every major occult leader including Madam H.P. Blavatsky, Aleister Crowley, Manly P. Hall and Albert Pike.”

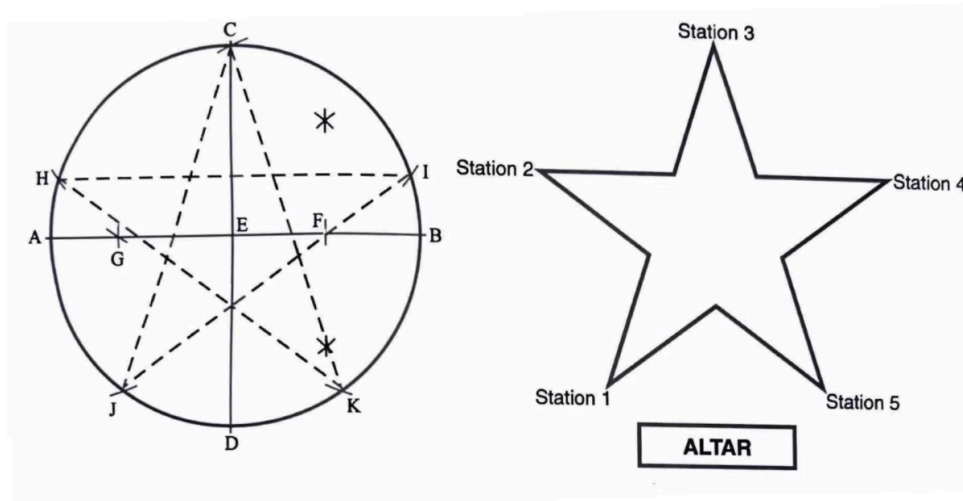

Black Greek Letter Organizations

“It is important to keep in mind that fraternities and sororities have a much longer history than most of their critics realize, and are part of a larger group that can be described secret and ritualistic societies, many of which trace their origins to Freemasonry. ... Dr. Elizabeth Fine in her new book *Soulstepping: Development and Transformation of African American Step Show*, has an anecdote about the African American fraternity Alpha Phi Alpha, who had their first initiation in a Masonic lodge hall. The brothers opened some of the lockers and used lodge attire to enhance the rites.⁴ African American fraternities, indeed almost all fraternities, were indeed influenced by Freemasonry. ... the Phi Beta Sigma history remarks that ‘Of course many practices are based upon the Masonic influence...’²¹”

“**Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. (ΑΦΑ)** is the oldest intercollegiate historically African American fraternity. It was initially a literary and social studies club organized in the 1905–1906 school year at Cornell University but later evolved into a fraternity with a founding date of December 4, 1906. It employs an icon from Ancient Egypt, the [Great Sphinx of Giza](#), as its symbol. Its aims or pillars are ‘Manly Deeds, Scholarship, and Love For All Mankind,’ and its motto is ‘First of All, Servants of All, We Shall Transcend All.’ Its archives are preserved at the Moorland-Spingarn Research Center. **Chapters were chartered at Howard University and Virginia Union University in 1907.**” According to the official story, [Charles Cardoza Poindexter](#) decided the club should be changed into a fraternity after reading about [Pi Gamma Omicron](#), a Black fraternity at Ohio State University (whose existence could not later be verified). “The divisive issue of whether the terms ‘club’ or ‘fraternity’ should be used was still debated.^[11] A vote again confirmed the name Alpha Phi Alpha with the colors of old gold and black.^[10] The initiation of new members **Eugene Kinckle Jones**, Lemuel Graves, and Gordon Jones took place on October 30, 1906, at a Masonic Hall including^[10] James Morton was considered and selected, but at the time he was not registered at the

university.^[5] Two founding members learned about fraternity rituals from other fraternal organizations: Henry A. Callis worked in the [Sigma Alpha Epsilon](#) fraternity House, and Kelly worked at [Beta Theta Pi](#) fraternity house.^[4] ... Callis said that these fraternities, SAE and BTP, were the source of the fraternity rituals.^[4]”

“Eugene Kinckle Jones ... A versatile leader, he organized the first three fraternity chapters that branched out from Cornell—Beta at Howard, Gamma at Virginia Union University, and the original Delta at the University of Toronto in Canada. In addition to becoming Alpha Chapter’s second president and joining with Callis in creating the fraternity name, Jones was a member of the first Committees on Constitution and Organization and helped write the fraternity ritual. ... George Biddle Kelley ... Not only was he the strongest proponent of the fraternity idea among the organization’s founders, the civil engineering student also became Alpha Chapter’s first president. In addition, he served on committees that worked out the handshake and ritual. Kelley was popular with the brotherhood. ... Nathaniel Allison Murray ... He was a member of Alpha Chapter’s first committee on organization of the new fraternal group, as well as the Committee on the Grip. ... Robert Harold Ogle ... Ogle joined Kelley in working out the first ritual and later became a charter member of Washington’s Mu Lambda Chapter.”

“In the school years of 1910-11, a small group of Black students attended Indiana University. Most of them were working their way through school. The number of places where they might assemble was limited. Realizing that they had no part in the university’s social life and were drawn together by common interests, they

decided that a Greek letter fraternity would do much to fill the missing link in their college existence. ... Two of these men, Elder Watson Diggs and Byron Kenneth Armstrong, had previously attended Howard University and had come into contact with men belonging to the only national Black Greek letter fraternity currently in existence. Their experiences at Howard gave rise to the chief motivating spirits that sowed the seed for a fraternity at Indiana University and crystallized the idea of establishing an independent Greek letter organization. Consequently, eight other men met with Diggs and Armstrong for the purpose of organizing such a fraternity. The charter members were Elder Watson Diggs, Byron K. Armstrong, John M. Lee, Henry T. Asher, Marcus P. Blakemore, Guy L. Grant, Paul W. Caine, George W. Edmonds, Ezra D. Alexander, and Edward G. Irvin.”

“Founder Elder Watson Diggs was a quiet, polished, scholarly, and prolific writer. Initially referred to as ‘the Father of Kappa,’ he became affectionately known as ‘the Dreamer’ due to his profound vision to create the fraternity. ... Based on the hostile attitude and circumstances facing Black people at Indiana University, Diggs established a fraternity on campus to give African Americans support and sanctuary based on high Christian ideals and the purpose of achievement. Diggs assisted Byron & Irven Armstrong in designing the fraternity’s Coat of Arms, assumed responsibility for preparing the initiation ceremonial forms, completed the fraternity’s Constitution, and took a course in Greek heraldry and mythology to ensure the fraternity was rooted in authenticity. He was one of two Founders who pawned his watch to pay for the Fraternity’s incorporation fee. Diggs wrote the lyrics to the Kappa Hymn. Additionally, he established *The Kappa Alpha Nu Journal*, the second periodical of any national Black college fraternity. He is the fraternity’s longest-serving Grand Polemarch; his tenure was during the first six years of the fraternity’s existence. He also served as a Grand Board Member and as Grand Historian. He also established nine of the initial undergraduate chapters in addition to the Indianapolis (IN) Alumni Chapter. Diggs was awarded the first Past Grand Polemarch’s medal and the first Laurel Wreath. He also assisted in writing *The 1928 Handbook of Kappa Alpha Psi®®*.”

The members of our bond have been the leaders in all fields of achievement within the city, let alone the country. Our members have always reached for the stars. As such, we have been blessed to name amongst our rolls several outstanding members of the Black Greek Letter Community. Of these, Central Lodge Number 1 has enjoyed a relationship with Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated. ... Two of the founders of the fraternity (Elder Watson Diggs and Ezra Alexander), as well as the first two Grand Polemarchs of Kappa Alpha Psi (Diggs and Irven Armstrong) were initiated into Central. 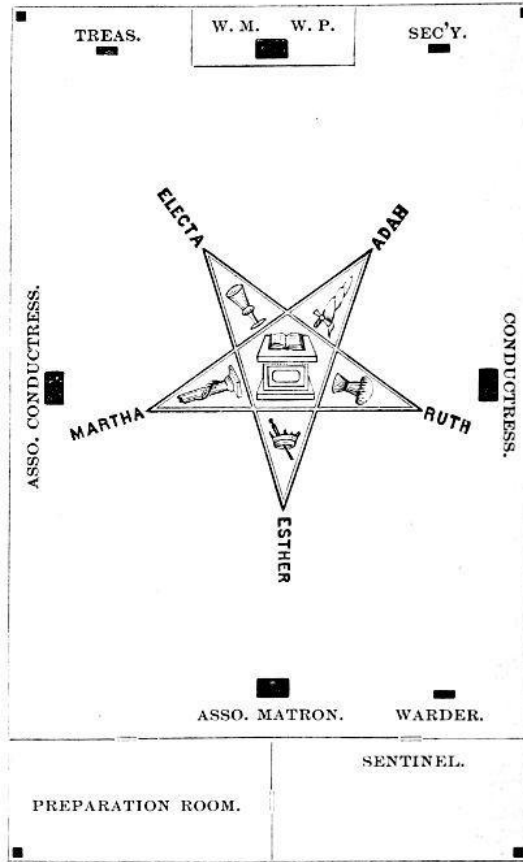

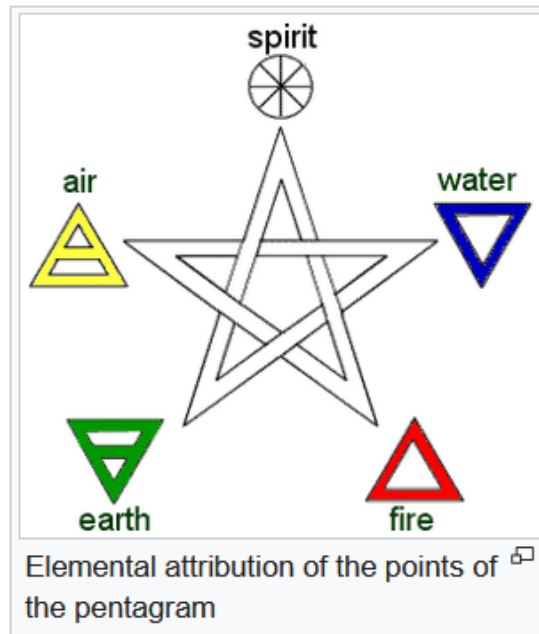

- "6. That the obligation of our Order, voluntarily assumed, is perpetual, from the force of which there is no release. ... Membership can only be forfeited by dimission, suspension, or expulsion from a Chapter, excepting that the suspension or expulsion of a brother from a Masonic Lodge, for any other cause than non-payment of dues, deprives him of all the rights of membership in this Order until reinstated by the Masonic body."

- "In the center of the Chapter room there should be an Altar, standing upon the center of a Five-pointed Star, having the five colors of the Order, with the white point towards the west. Upon the Altar should be an open Bible. In the East, there should be a pedestal with a Gavel thereon for the use of the presiding officer. Each Chapter should have a Seal, Signet, and one or more small Bibles, a Sword and Veil for Adah, Culms of Barley for Ruth, a Crown and Scepter for Esther, a Broken Column for Martha, and a Cup for Electa; they may also have banners with appropriate emblems thereon."

- “You have doubtless well considered the step you have taken in seeking admission to this Order, dedicated to Charity, Truth, and Loving-kindness. You came here of your own free choice. Complain not, therefore, at any trial. A seal is here set upon your lips. Let it warn you to be ever silent and secret, as to all that may be made known to you here. Be not weary in well-doing. Woe unto those who seek to take upon themselves burdens which they cannot bear. Woe unto the faithless and insincere, who assume obligations lightly and forthwith forget them. ‘Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct thy paths.’”
