

1. Does the league provide refunds, even in the event there aren't enough coaches or my child does not make the team?
Registration fees are **non-refundable** with the exception of if your child cannot be placed on a team.
2. Does my player need to try out for a team even if they were placed on a AA or Majors team last year?
Yes; all players need to try out for AA and Majors regardless of previous experience in order to be placed on a team.
3. Does the league offer payment plans?
