What is a Committee Member?

A Committee Member of Texas THON is a student at the University of Texas at Austin who participates in the student organization, Texas THON, by:

- Fundraising year-round for Dell Children's Medical Center through peer-to-peer fundraising
- Attending all Texas THON-hosted events
- Working on specialized projects with the Leadership Team

All Committee Members Are Expected To:

- Attend all respective meetings
 - 1-hour biweekly internal meetings
 - Every other Tuesday from 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm at Greg Lounge, starting on Tuesday, September 15th
 - These meetings involve all Leadership and Committee members in Texas THON and communicate information about upcoming events, fundraising pushes, resources, brainstorming sessions, socials, and updates to our program goals
 - 1-hour weekly to biweekly meetings with your committee
 - These committee meetings are led by the team's Assistant Director and Chair(s) to accomplish the goals of the respective committee
 - The Assistant Director will be in charge of delegating duties and maintaining morale for the committee
 - The time, date, location, and frequency of these meetings are up to the discretion of the committee's Assistant Director based on the availability of those in the committee
 - Attend all Texas THON events
 - Absences to be evaluated on a case-by-case basis
 - Participate in Texas THON until the conclusion of the fundraising year in March
 - Communicate in an effective and timely manner with all members of the Management Team and Leadership Team (24-hour replies, etc)
 - **Meet scheduled fundraising checkpoints based on a year-long committee fundraising goal of \$500**
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Committee Descriptions

Division	Committee	Description
Communications	Member Development	Oversees Texas THON internal education and fosters culture.
Communications	Production	Captures and edits photos and videos from Texas THON events.
Communications	Publicity	Designs promotional materials and manages social media accounts.
Communications	Stewardship	Recognizes and appreciates all Texas THON supporters.
Events	Dance Marathon Logistics	Manages and plans any and all things related to Texas THON's final event of the year.
Events	Event Fundraising	Responsible for external fundraising and campus collaboration events. Puts together events such as Pancake Night, Fire in the Hole, Pickle for a Purpose, etc.
Events	Family & Community Relations	The main contact for Miracle Families from Dell Children's. Plans and organizes family events and hosts events to involve the Austin community.
Finance	Finance & Data Tracking	Manages budgets, tracks donations, and celebrates fundraising milestones.
Finance	Member Fundraising	Empowers individuals and teams with tools to reach their fundraising goals.
Finance	Merchandise	Creates and sells Texas THON apparel and products.
Finance	Partnership	Builds relationships with local businesses that secure food and event support.
Recruitment	Greek Recruitment	Recruits and maintains relationships with Greek teams.

Recruitment	High School Relations	Partners with local K-12 schools to start dance marathon programs of their own.
Recruitment	Miracle Maker Relations	Supports and manages Miracle Maker progress.
Recruitment	Student/ Spirit Org Recruitment	Recruits and maintains relationships with student and spirit organization teams.
