

Sanitize, Space & Safe: Mitigation Strategies to Support Community Health

Crowd Size Restrictions

- Limit student gatherings in one area to less than the number identified by the County's defined limit (currently 250). When possible, we will try to keep group sizes at about 30 (one class section) with up to 60 in large group areas.

Hallway/Transition Pathways

- Reduced capacity and density
- Students will walk on the right side of the hall
- Limit congregating in the hall before school and during lunch (Point A to Point B)

Maintain Accurate Records

Attendance

- Accurate attendance records are essential

Bathroom Breaks

- Emergency only: Prioritize face-to-face learning
- Record Form or QR Code

Hallway Escort (Healthroom, Counselors, Advising)

- Students going to the office, student services, healthroom or leaving early should be escorted.
- Admin/Counselor will call teacher and request the student meet in the hall
- Teacher will use student removal protocol to request an escort
 - Call office to request an escort
 - Student waits in the hallway
 - Student escorted to location

TRADITIONAL FACE TO FACE ONLY: Lunch (Limit Crowding/Monitor Student Social Groups)

Students report to lunch locations based on grade level

- Freshmen and Sophomores (810 spots)
 - English Wing (250/250)
 - 167, 165, 164, 160, 155, 154, 152, 151
 - Cafeteria (250)
 - South Cafeteria (60)
- Juniors and Seniors (500 spots)
 - Social Studies Wing (225)
 - 101, 102, 104, 105, 107, 110, 114, 115, 117
 - North Cafeteria (125)
 - East Campus (50)
 - Math Wing (Overflow)
 - 300, 301, 303, 318, 319

Entrance/Exit: Doors Open at 6:50am and Close at 3:00pm**Report Directly to Block A**

- Main Cafeteria at 6:30am (early arrival- Field House)- Sign in
- Entrances staffed at 6:55am
- School and classroom doors open at 6:55am (doors will be open prior to staff arriving)
- North Entrance (OAC Lot and NHI Buses)
- South Entrance (Field House Lot and SLI Buses)
- Late arrivals/job release/early release (Main Office)
- East Campus until 3:30pm
- Main Cafeteria until 3:30pm in tradition face-to-face

Safe Practice Expectations

- Teach with doors open, but locked for safety
- Sanitize hands at entry and exit
- Limit crowding at the door and tables
- Remove all hallway furniture
- Offer cleaning wipe for cell phones
- Limit the sharing of materials
- Maintain and enforce seating chart
- Keep track of students leaving for the bathroom
- Classroom dismissed in a controlled structured; no congregating by the door

Masks

- Teachers will wear masks
- Students will wear masks on the bus and campus.
- Students are exempt from wearing masks during physical education, physical activity and competition. Students can take a mask break with staff direction when proper social distancing can occur
