

Sight Word Activity Grid



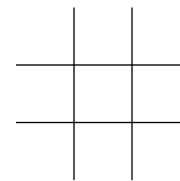
Sing a Song:

Click the video below to hear the directions. Then pick a sight word from the list. Try using the same tune to make your own song. If you can, have a caregiver send a video to your teacher of you singing your sight word song.

Tic Tac Toe:

Using any kind of paper at the tic tac toe board. Be sure

the spaces big enough for you to write your words. Pick two sight words and find a partner. You will write one sight word and your partner will write the other word. Remember to take turns, and try to get three of your words in a row. Have fun!



Building Towers:

On paper, write your sight words, then tape them to the cups. Read each sight word attached to the cup as you use it to build your tower. When finished, read each sight word as you stack your cups to put away. See how tall your tower can get!!



Chalk Syllables:

Outside on your driveway or sidewalk, write the sight words. Then practice clapping out the syllables. Draw a box with chalk around each syllable (just like you did with the syllable cards).

Parents: You can have your learner write the words on a piece of paper before heading outside.
