

# Approaching the Unknown

Understanding your team's problem-solving process

## Overview

Our ability to approach the unknown in a positive way is a vital skill in today's rapidly changing world. Do you know *how* you and your team approach problems, both personally and as a group? Want to find out? This unique development opportunity uses the thrill of an escape room and the skill of a professional facilitator to document your team's communication and decision-making processes.

Following the session, we facilitate a discussion to understand and consider the basis for how the decisions were made, and draw parallels between in-game and work scenarios. The debrief is enhanced by reviewing recorded footage of key in-game moments. Importantly, we then consider what the impact would have been if key moments were approached differently, using a host of cognitive tools and techniques.

## Format

- Escape room session (45 minutes per group of 5)
  - Per group debrief session (45 minutes per group of 5)
  - Whole team debrief session (30 minutes, for more than one group)

## Requirements

Conducted in-person at our Geraldton Studio. This activity can be set up and facilitated in your workplace, however additional requirements exist for the operation of the escape room element.

- Guides a team's creative problem-solving and collaboration skills.
- Agile problem solving, decision making, and abductive reasoning.
