The New Lebanon Local School Board of Education met for a regular meeting on June 29, 2021 at 6:00 pm. at the New Lebanon High School Multi-Purpose Room, New Lebanon, Ohio. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mrs. Crawford.

Roll Call

Textbook Adoption Presentation for Public Input - Dena Shepard

Mrs. Shepard presented how the district teacher teams meet and the process of determining textbook recommendations. She then explained that this year the ELA and reading textbooks were due for adoption. Further, she explained the two parts that are required of ELA/Reading textbooks: informational and literary. She then passed around to the Board and public teacher's manual versions of the recommended textbooks.

Susie Couch asked where the Ohio learning standards come from. Mrs. Shepard shared that Ohio Department of Education (ODE) sets those standards and they are listed on the ODE website.

Theresa Hines asked about what to do if they disagree with information or curriculum being taught. Mrs. Shepard referenced the annual public textbook adoption input meetings and also suggested contacting ODE for any Ohio learning standard concerns.

Susie Couch asked if a parent elects to homeschool if they are required to follow Ohio learning standards. Mrs. Shepard shared that homeschools are allowed to pick their own curriculum and therefore would not be required to follow Ohio learning standards. However, homeschools are required to submit their curriculum to the public school district of residence as well as Montgomery County.

Susie Couch, Tim Back Jr., Brian Groff, and Theresa Hines expressed concerns over sections of material in the textbook presented referencing critical race theory. A discussion continued regarding if all textbooks that meet Ohio learning standards would contain such material.

Recognition of Visitors/Public Participation (3 min.maximum per speaker)

Tina Bell expressed concerns that education (nationwide) has moved towards opinions rather than factual learning.

Theresa Hines expressed concerns that tax payers' desires on what their children/grandchildren are being educated on is not being heard.

Susie Couch asked how to change textbooks that they do not agree with and how to take out sections they do not agree with. She asked how long critical race theory has been in the curriculum. She also asked for guidance on how to change Ohio learning standards. Further, she expressed concern over lack of historical learning, stating the historical information in the ELA textbook presented was inaccurate. She also asked which class the textbook presented tonight would be taught to. Mrs. Shepard replied with fifth grade. Mrs. Couch continued to state that school textbooks and curriculum are indoctrinating students.

Tim Back Jr. requested to return to older textbooks before critical race theory was introduced. He expressed being upset with the District for allowing it to be taught to his child. He also accused the ELA textbook presented of teaching false history.

Brian Groff asked if the textbooks presented had already been approved. He also expressed concern over an excerpt of text labeled "It's ok to be weird," stating that it was concerning to label a child weird. He further went on to state he feels the school doesn't care about the students or this wouldn't be taught. He also expressed concern about having a mock presidential election where votes were cast out loud. He stated his child was bullied after expressing her opinion. He also asked why we have a waiting list for preschool and why we can't open another preschool class. Mr. Moore explained we currently don't have the physical space but that the Board had inquired about this at their last work session. Mr. Groff asked what a modular or trailer classroom would cost to expand the preschool. He also inquired about using the multi-purpose building to add another preschool classroom. Further, he expressed concern that the District was spending \$22,000 on a new LED sign for DES instead of adding another preschool class. He questioned the Board and District's priorities. Finally, he asked about the preschool lottery and when/where that is being advertised.

Tim Back Sr. asked the Board members present if they will end teaching critical race theory.

Chloe Chatterton addressed the Board that she was being taught that white/European people ran the Native Americans out of America and that she and her family disagreed with that. She then said she was told by a teacher that all white people are racist.

Cara Morgan asked each Board member their name and term expiration. She also asked Mrs. Shepard and Ms. Huck their names and if they were elected positions.

Michelle Parks was concerned that a teacher spoke to Chloe Chatterton about all white people being racist. She also expressed concern that teachers push their

opinions and political beliefs onto students. She also asked how teaching plans are developed by the teaching teams.

Sarah Thompson stated her older child went through grades 1-12 and couldn't tell his teachers' political opinions. She expressed concern for her younger children that they will not have the same environment. She stated that she emailed teachers and principals about her concerns. Finally, she also expressed concerns that students aren't allowed to have differing views from teachers. She continued to state that having discussions on opposing viewpoints was necessary, but students needed to be able to disagree with teachers.

Sherry Myers asked about masks and vaccinations. She inquired if vaccinations were required for students or if they would be required to wear masks this upcoming school year. Mrs. Shepard shared that as of June 2, 2021 students were no longer required to wear face masks. Mrs. Crawford also shared that there are no requirements for students to be vaccinated. However, she reminded the group that we must follow all State and Montgomery County Health Department mandates.

Glenna Madden asked about making the DES art teacher mobile instead of having a dedicated room solely for art. She also asked if preschool is eligible for open enrollment. Mrs. Shepard stated that all preschoolers must reside in the New Lebanon Local School District. Mrs. Shepard also explained that under federal law we are required to hold a certain number of spots for special education preschool students.

Betty Hall expressed concern over the COVID vaccines and opening them to young children. She asked who the District is required to follow for those guidelines. Mrs. Crawford stated we are required to follow State and Montgomery County Health Department mandates.

Sherri Neaves summarized that what she heard tonight is that the District is restricted a lot by the Ohio learning standards. She stated that she thinks the people they really need to speak with would be state representatives rather than the Board. She asked if we could ask a state representative to meet with the group to express their concerns. Mrs. Leonard distributed papers with state representative names and contact information to those in attendance and stated that would be the best way to contact them.
