Updates

JH/KW: delay on website course booking, new website almost ready.

Finance

RH: Finance function running smoothly. Currently working on preparing accounts to support search for new premises.

JH: Membership will be consulted on requirements for new premises. New Premises Working Group

Women's Night

SD: Women's Night: Name has changed to "Womxn's Night" to support inclusivity of trans and non-binary folks. The ambiguity of the pronunciation reflects the nature of gender fluidity. JH: Currently recruiting new coordinator from existing members to be filled by 16th April.

FOM

JH: Going well. New co-ordinator will be recruited to share with JH. There is some more capacity for users.

SD: Asks is there a mechanism to ensure EAB drop-outs (or people showing interest) are told about FOM and do not disappear. JH to check on this

SD: Asks do we have plans to contact EAB/FOMers to follow up after they have earned their bike. JH to check with KW on the process.

Volunteer Nights

SiD: New EAB worksheets printed. Clearer on order of tasks and detail, requirements for handing bikes over to EAB. All: Feedback to Julien with any comments on the worksheet.

Planning meetings for all volunteers to attend, discuss the sessions, understand co-ordinator roles etc. SiD actioning.

Trading Arm

GC: Repairs busy; 1 week waiting list. Sale bikes demand is challenging. Peer reviews are underway. 1 to 1 peer review discussions to take place. JH to facilitate the first round of reviews.

ASB

Email from LF: Will arrange feedback/discussion session similar to volunteer nights.

EAB

TS: Been a bit short on volunteers who can commit to regular sessions due to some long term absences. Getting enough bikes through. Velcro labelling of bikes has been implemented.

- Print disclaimer in large that can be stuck up on the workshop door for WN, BK, FAB & ASB
 (KW) "This is a DIY and DIT (Do it Together!) workshop! By using this workshop, you are
 agreed to fix your own bike and to take responsibility for any work done and any associated
 risks." DONE! Is it up?? (KW)
- Upload volunteer comms channels code of conduct to whatsapp and FB and inform coordinators (KW) - DONE!

Other Issues

Second hand wheels: Need to establish a process to ensure numbers of second hand wheels meet demand for EAB, and for sale at BK / WN.

GC: Cannot guarantee quality of second hand wheels. Therefore, the only advantage of pre-preparing them is saving time in BK / WN. Would be useful to set up colour coding system so we can see how many and in what state. Always need more rear 700c's.
