 - Since early March, we (students) have mapped some areas in Poland and Moldova to support displaced people from Ukraine by remote. This activity was reported on University's news, TV news, and web articles. Also in mid March, we (students and faculties) organized some online workshops telling the abstract and use cases of UNVT to the HOT Asia pacific community members. In October, we (students) participated in "OSS4SDG hackathon" (online) organized by the UN and the EC, and our team was selected as one of the finalists. From November 21 to 25, we (students and faculty) participated in "Pista ng Mapa / State of the Map Asia 2022" in the Philippines on site, and presented our Activities by LT.

We made a manual for importing CityGML data into OSM, and submitted it, then our work was selected as one of 8 finalists out of 49 teams.
