### Race Day Substitutions & Scratches

This outlines how substitutions and scratches are to be handled on race day:

**Sprint Categories of U10, U12, U14, Masters and Para:** substitutions and scratches can be made during race day by way of the Competition Manager.

**Sprint Categories of U21:** can only be changed with a paper change form with the Competition Manager.

	U10 - U14, Masters, Para categories: U10 - U14: K1/C1 200m, 500m, 3000m K2/C2 200m, 500m, 3000m K4/C4 200m, 500m
	<b>Masters/Para:</b> K1/C1 200m, 500m, 1000m K2/C2 200m, 500m, 1000m K4/C4 upon request
	Race limit: *** 8 Sprint events per athlete ***
	Note: Athletes are allowed to race only 1 age category in singles disciplines. Athletes are allowed to race in multiple age categories in teams - doubles and/or fours.
	U21 Canada Summer Games Trials Events: U21: K1/C1 200m, 500m, 1000m
	Volunteers and officials will meet 45 minutes prior to the start of the races each morning. Coaches will be asked to check in sometime prior to the start of races for a 5 minute briefing.
Rules	Canoe Kayak Canada Competition Rules will be used.
	Rowing course of 6 lanes will be used, thus there will be only 6 athletes in each race. Final B (and possibly C, D, etc) will be raced in those categories, which will have more than 1 Heat.
Categories	U10: Born in the year 2015 or later U12: Born in the year 2013, 2014 U14: Born in the year 2011, 2012 U21: Born in the year 2004 or later
	Masters: Athletes that are 25+
	Paracanoe: Athletes meeting ICF Paracanoe requirement
Technical	<ul> <li>Clubs are expected to bring their own deck numbers.</li> <li>U16 and younger athletes MUST wear PFDs approved under the small vessels regulations within Canada's Shipping Act</li> <li>5 minutes to start may not be called for every race. 3 and 1 minute will be called</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>CKBC scale will be used for weight boat control for singles races in U21 category, the boats will be weight after every race</li> </ul>
Trailers	Trailer parking will be communicated closer to the regatta date
Security	Equipment Security will be provided on Saturday night only.
Miscellaneous Information	<ul> <li>No athletes will be allowed on water until 45 min prior to the first race start time</li> <li>Coaches are asked to check in with the Event Manager (Stan Marek) upon arrival to the site</li> <li>WAR CANOE races MIGHT be included as a demonstration disciplines, the exact format will be discussed with coaches and communicated back to the clubs</li> <li>We are planning to have designated practice time on Friday evening for those who wish to paddle AND weight the boat - the scale will be available on Friday evening and Saturday morning prior to the first race - details will be released and communicated closer to the regatta dates</li> <li>There shall be NO TENTS placed at the parking lot - all tents and athletes shall be located up at the grandstands. Only trailers and boats will be located in the front part of the parking lot</li> <li>ICF SUP disciplines will be included in the regatta, separate Info package will be distributed</li> </ul>
