The Montessori Method is an intriguing approach to education for all ages, and one component to this method is the way that communication and verbalization is utilized. In a typical Montessori classroom there can be seen young children that have already achieved an advanced level of oral and written communication before entering an elementary classroom. This is attributed to their freedom to communicate and work in small self-formed groups together during the work cycles and throughout the day. As guides, we model through our own interactions and role-play how to communicate through various scenarios, which aids the heroes in real life situations.
