GEAR UP	Tutoring: In the first 3 weeks of February, we provided 56 walk-in tutoring sessions (26
	students served). In addition to providing push-in tutors for the Pre-Algebra classes at SMS,

	Credit Recovery: We currently have 14 students enrolled in our Project Based Learning
	Credit Recovery Biology course. We also provided walk-in tutoring for students needing help
	with credit-recovery Edgenuity classes.
	College Preparation: We had 18 students attend our scholarship workshop on 2/2 and are
	continuing to help students complete scholarships and college applications. On 2/28 we are
	taking students to tour UNM and experience LoboDay. In addition, students will also tour the
	UNM Health and Science Center that afternoon to talk with healthcare professionals about
	career opportunities.
	Career Preparation: We are working with Ms. Etscorn to have students create resumes in
	the 11th grade English class, and we are hosting a resume building workshop on 3/2. On 3/7
	we are hosting a College & Career Fair and organizing a "Mock IT Till You Rock It" event to
	help students practice their interview skills.
	Student Leadership: Our student leadership club is currently reading through the "The 7
	Habits of Highly Effective Teens". They are also creating a video to help welcome the 8th

	"Earth Week" in April where they will create different activities with a focus on community

	Professional Development: We sent two math teachers to TI calculator training in Santa Fe
