## August 8, 2022

### Village Board Meeting

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#### Call to Order

President Farr called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. in a hybrid model, in person and via video conference for remote participants, per the Governor's executive order on Covid 19 guidance.

#### Public Commentary and Guests

Michael East, 15 Blossom Lane, provided input on a residence (59 Overlook) that has been overgrown and also has some standing water, thus mosquitos are plentiful in the area and bothersome to his backyard as well. Trustee Der Avedisian also has been engaged with the resident around water issues. A permit has been extended for building a pool. President Farr asked that we reach out to the resident to attend to the unkempt

premises and issues with the yard/pool. Trustee Tillman will reach out to Bob Hammer to discuss the issues with the resident.

## **Police Report**

Chief McEnerney will distribute his monthly summary of activity after the meeting. The Ford Explorer was repaired and is working well. He has also hired a new police officer, Bob Caviani, who specializes in community relations and worked here before. The Chief complimented Trustee Shine on the landscaping work done around the parking lot.

President Farr relayed that a Golf road resident is interested in slowing down the traffic and offered their driveway to help with any patrol needed.

## **Engineer's Report**

Brian Wesolowski was called by a resident who has a tree that was affected by a patio installation in a neighbor's yard. The resident wanted to determine if there were policies around protecting the trees in the Village. Village Attorney Bruce Huvard explaining the current tree ordinance and if there was damage, the ordinance could apply to the situation. Brian will inform the resident of the ordinance.

### **Public Buildings and Grounds Department**

Trustee Shine got positive feedback about the trees being removed, hastas were planted where the trees were previously. new additions to the Village. The board asked Trustee Shine to come back with a recommendation and phased approach for planting.

#### **Streets and Sanitation Department**

Trustee Kalogerakos shared that the stop signs will be started this month. A resident had inquired about the orange flags at Briar and Clyde, which were placed for the utility company. They will start with 25 stop signs and then do the remaining signs once that is complete. The board complimented the work on the hydrants.

#### **Utilities Department**

The cross connection reports are being collected as well as the water bills.

Trustee Der Avedisian received vintage posters from long time resident, Warren Fellingham. If we can have the posters secured, then these posters would not only be a great addition, but also a nice remembrance donated by the Fellinghams. President Farr agreed that we should pursue this addition.

### **President's Report**

President Farr shared an update on 1 Briar; the IL PGA would like us to secure the lease for the parking spaces. He also shared that the newsletter will be distributed.

He received a complaint from a Glenview resident about the lawnmowing noise on the Glenview Club golf course. The course is following the Glenview noise ordinance, which allows them to mow at 5am.

President Farr reminded the board that there are several terms that expire in 2023, and that if anyone is interested in being involved with the Board to reach out to them about the position.

Trustee Der Avedisian moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Kalogerakos seconded. The meeting was adjourned unanimously at 8:07pm.
