Directions

Cary Street Gym & Cary Street Field

Arriving from the east or south by Interstate 64W/95N:

- Take Exit 76A for Chamberlayne Avenue.
- At the next light, turn right onto West Leigh Street.
- Turn left about 8 blocks onto N. Harrison St.
- Turn left after about 16 (short) blocks on W. Cary St.
- The field/gym are on your right

Arriving from the west or north by Interstate 64E/95S:

- Take Exit 76B for Belvidere Street.
- At the first light, turn right onto West Leigh Street.
- Turn left about 8 blocks onto N. Harrison St.
- Turn left after about 16 (short) blocks on W. Cary St.
- The field/gym are on your right

MCV Campus Recreation Center

Arriving from the east or south by Interstate 64W/95N:

- Take Exit 76A for Chamberlayne Avenue.
- At the next light, turn right onto West Leigh Street.
- Turn left onto N.10th
- The field/gym are on your left

Athletic Trainer


