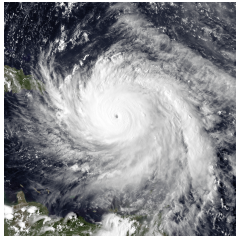

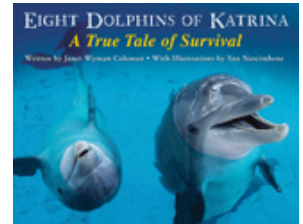

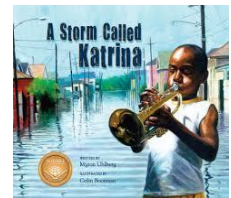

Hurricane Katrina	
Category 5 major hurricane (SSHWS/N)	
Formed	August 23, 2005
Dissipated	August 30, 2005
Highest winds	1-minute sustained: 175 (280 km/h)
Lowest pressure	902 mbar (hPa); 26.64 in
Fatalities	1,836 confirmed
Damage	\$108 billion (2005 USD) (Costliest hurricane in U history)

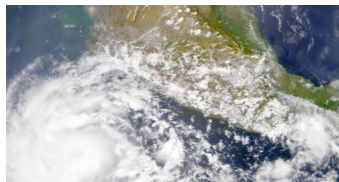

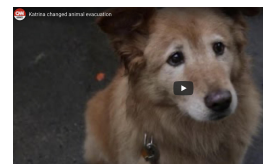
