



Flexible Scheduling Option (FSO) 2023-2024

This contract is an agreement between the parent, student and Arrowhead High School regarding the Flexible Scheduling Option. FSO allows Juniors and Seniors to arrive late or leave early. Students may take one less course or have one less study hall each semester.

Qualifications

- No outstanding fees (*If the payment of student fees is a hardship, please notify your Counselor*)
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0
 - If you earned a 3.0 GPA in the most recent semester and qualify in all other areas, you may apply for consideration by meeting with your counselor
- Must not have any F's
- Must not have 2 or more D's
- Be on track to graduate:
 - 26 credits by the end of the 10th grade school year
 - 39 credits by the end of the 11th grade school year
- No pre-expulsion, expulsion, suspensions or school-related police citations (including truancy citations)
- Not exceed 4 tardies to period following FSO
- FSO may be revoked for behavior and/or attendance issues
- Student's full time status may be affected if they become ineligible for FSO. This could impact WIAA athletics, Social Security benefits, automobile insurance, etc.

Registration

- 1 Select either N6000A/N6000B Arrive Late or N6001A/N6001B Leave Early on Course Selection Worksheet and Online Registration semesters
- 2 Students who want to add FSO to an existing schedule must have either a 1st or 10th hour open. Scheduled classes cannot be moved to add FSO.
- 3 See the *Arrowhead High School Student and Parent Information Guide* or your school counselor for more details.
