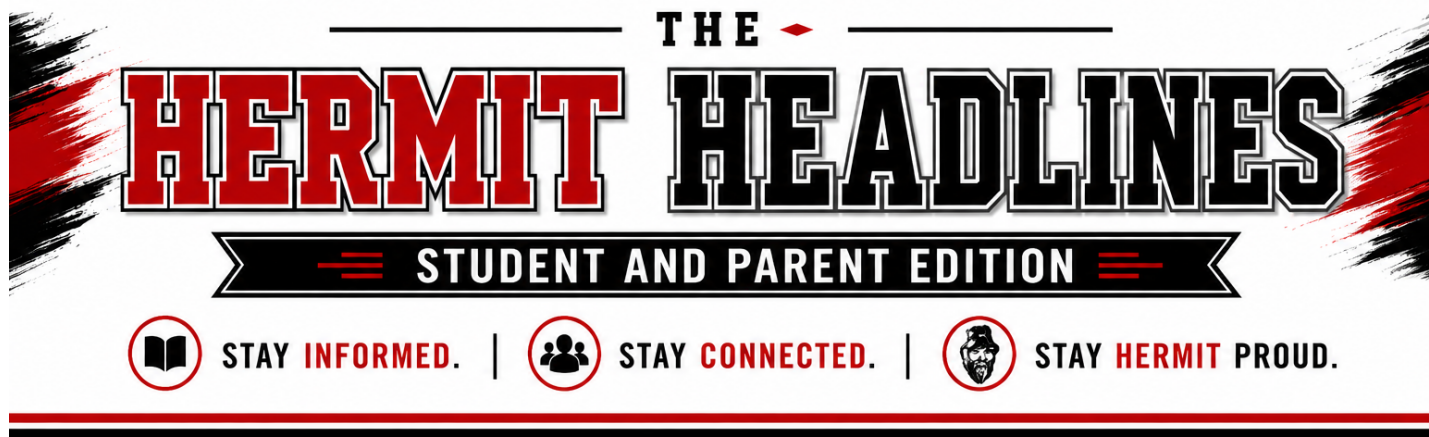

Arrival and Dismissal:

Students should NOT arrive on campus before 7:30 AM. At 7:45 AM, all students will report to their first period classes. At 7:55 AM, the tardy bell for first period will ring. At 3:25 PM, school ends for the day. All students should be off-campus by 3:30 PM unless they have a sports activity and are supervised by their coach.

Hustle Time (Advisory):

For this week, students will go to their Advisory teachers during Hustle Time (after lunch for grades 7-9 and after 5th period for grades 10-12).

Schedule Changes:

Students will complete the schedule change forms on the table outside the office. Once completed, turn them in to Mrs. Cindy, the High School Secretary.

Reminders:

- Cell phones must be silenced and stored in your backpacks before arriving on the HHS campus.
- If you drive to school, you must get out of your vehicle IMMEDIATELY upon arriving on campus.
- Only water in a clear container is allowed in HHS classrooms and hallways. Any drinks you bring for lunch should be stored in your backpack before arriving on campus.
- Only clear or mesh backpacks are allowed on campus.
- Dress Code:

9.4.1 K-12 Guidelines:

- No clothing that exposes underwear, buttocks, or breasts of a female shall be allowed. (Act 835 of 2011)
- Blouses and shirts must be long enough to cover the midriff, back, and stomach. Sleeveless shirts must be at least 2 inches wide on the shoulder. No strapless or off-the-shoulder blouses or shirts are allowed.
- Foot coverings must be worn at all times to keep feet safe during the student's daily school activities, in accordance with their schedule.
- No hats, caps, hoodies, toboggans, etc., may be worn inside campus buildings. Items that obstruct the view of the student's face may be questioned at any time. Principals' discretion may be used for questionable head coverings.
- No clothing that displays messages or illustrations of a profane or crude nature, or advertisements for drugs, alcohol, or any illegal substance, or gang-related logos, is allowed.
- No pajamas or house shoes are allowed.
- Pants must be of proper size and worn at the waist.
- Shorts and skirt hemlines, and holes/rips/tears in pants, are permitted within a dollar bill's length of the top of the kneecap.

9.4.2 Grades 7 - 12

- All bags (backpacks, athletic bags, purses, etc.) used during the school day at Hermitage High School must be made of mesh or clear material.
