Facilities: Our track is an eight lane 400 meter All-Weather surface. Our high jump and long jump areas are on paved surfaces. The shot and discus areas are concrete / gravel. There are no dressing facilities, but restrooms are available near the concession stand.

Concessions: Will be open during the majority of the event.

Spikes: Spikes longer than 1/4" are not permitted and ONLY "Pyramid" version spikes are permitted. Any athlete with spikes other than described above will be disqualified.

Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$300.00 per school or \$150 for either the boys or girls team. Make checks payable to Monroe Athletics. Teams approved to enter a "B" team shall pay 2 entry fees.

Sports Medicine: Our Athletic Trainer will be on site for the event. Athletic Training services will be provided by Premier Health Network / Atrium Hospital.

Scoring: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 (Timed Finals - no prelims)

Awards: Award packets will be distributed to each coach following the meet (please report any discrepancies immediately). There will not be an on site Awards Presentation. Awards packets can be picked up in the stadium press box.

Coaches Instructions: There will be a Coaches Meeting held at the Timing Trailer at 4:15pm. At that time, Coaches should submit (per OHSAA rule) a signed [Coaches Verification of Sporting Conduct/Legal Equipment and Uniforms form](#) to the Meet Manager. Performance list and Heat Sheets will be distributed at the Coaches Meeting.

General Guidelines:

* Coaches...Please make sure to review these guidelines with your team:

1. All team camps are to be in the designated locations. Team Camps should not be in the bleachers.
2. Only participating athletes are to be on the track during competition. Athletes should wait to access the infield until their event is called.
3. All Athletes must enter the track from the clerking area and exit from the south end.
4. Spikes longer than 1/4" are not permitted, and pyramid type spikes ONLY...NO exceptions.
5. No track spikes or shots are permitted in the stands.
6. Only tennis balls and chalk are to be used on the track and jumping areas. Absolutely NO tape is permitted.
7. No radios--except those requiring earphones permitted.
8. No tape on the track. Chalk will be available if you need a marker.

Infield Policy:

Coaches are welcome to be in the infield anywhere **OTHER** than the timing area. **Athletes are not permitted to congregate in the infield. Athletes whose event has been called may be in the infield once they've checked in with the clerk while awaiting for their event.** If this becomes a problem, we will have to shut down the infield to coaches as well.

Team Drop Off and Bus Parking Information:

All team buses and vehicles should turn right when they reach the top of the hill on Hornet Drive off of Yankee Road and then follow the drive around the building and through the bus circle, past the Baseball Field and Tennis Courts to the entrance of the stadium. Buses and school vehicles should drop students off along the curb at the main entrance to the stadium. Once buses and team vehicles have completed their drop off, they should follow the drive around parking alongside the curb of the Elementary School playground if arriving prior to 4:00pm. After 4:00pm all team buses and vehicles should park on the front side of campus in the lot in front of the Monroe Elementary School entrance.

PLEASE NOTE: MONROE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DOES NOT DISMISS UNTIL 3:45PM AND THEREFORE TEAM TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES CANNOT BLOCK OR ENTER THIS AREA UNTIL AFTER 4:00PM.
