Rough chronological order (who arrives at Sol when, who's there in time to do things before Sasha goes chaos-goddess, who shows up shortly after)

Human battleplan (who goes to Wolf, who goes to AC, who goes to Sol from each of those systems, and when)

Move from Wolf to AC to reinforce Pinning Force and overwhelm AC defenders:

NOTE: The forces that are supposed to leave Wolf to go to AC are doing this as part of a premade battle plan, and will probably leave before the REST of the human fleet figures out they need to hurry to Sol.

^ Are you certain? The Centralists weren't even sure if they were going to be allowed to go into

Sol. The premade battle plan was that all SHITS would go from Wolf to AC. With the Centralist negotiations, that premade battle plan gets thrown in the blender because instead of “all of the coalition goes to AC” it becomes “only Klavostanis go to AC while the rest of the fleet goes to Sol”. And if the Chamarrans denied the Centralist request, the coalition could stick to the original premade plan. If the Chamarrans accepted (they did), then they go with the new “only Klavostanis go to AC while the rest of the fleet goes to Sol”

^^Er... wasn't there a plan for the AC pinning fleet to be reinforced? Or was the coalition planning to just *keep* the AC defenders pinned indefinitely?

^^^ The reinforcements were supposed to be all of the Coalition fleet at Wolf. The Centralites last minute change of plans from “go to AC only” into “go to AC AND Sol” might change that.

^^^^ OK, here's what I'm imagining hold on:

(SJ's Draft Timeline)

H-hour: humans hit Wolf and AC, more or less simultaneously but in unequal strength.
OMINOUS hits Xena. (?)

H+6: humans win at Wolf with overwhelming forces. Space battle is resolved Centralists have *already* decided they want to press on to Sol. They detach the Klavos to carry out the original plan of reinforcing the AC fleet, detail some of the subfleets at Wolf to occupy Wolf, and make ready to move to Sol.

H+12: K-K negotiations are arranged.

H+18: Klavostanis arrive at Alpha Centauri; remaining MEH fleet flees, realizing that it is now hopelessly outgunned. K-K negotiations are resolved. Centrality fleet departs Wolf for Sol, with some of the other international contingents in tow.

H+19 or 20: Some international contingents leave Alpha Centauri for Sol, either to pursue the AC fleet or to be 'in at the death' on general principles.

H+30 and on: Human fleets begin arriving in Sol system, hard on the heels of various OMINOUS contingents that left Xena for Sol around H+6 hours.

(This may contradict the idea that OMINOUS fleet, aside from Eoghan/Atlantean advance guard, holds back to await outcome of K-K negotiations- SJ)

(exact numbers of hours are made up just for flavor, except the 12-hour transit time)

There. That about wraps it up as a preliminary.

^^^^^ If the Klavostanis never agreed to go to Sol, yes, they might've gone ahead to AC before the rest move to Sol.

>>>> "*Centralists have already decided they want to press on to Sol.*" They had to send Kierger to Chamarra Prime in order to get clearance to go to Sol.

Oh god. When did they do this, after or before the battles of Wolf and AC started? [This is giving me a goddamn headache. Get FL in here to help straighten this mess out. Sometime. -SJ]
