the venue there will be security checks. I will have a security person check inside my bag.



I might also see some security dogs. This makes sure that everyone only brings safe things into the venue.

TICKETING



I can also buy a ticket at the venue but there might be a queue. If I have accessibility needs, I can go to the front of all queues.



I will then have my ticket scanned and access through into the venue.



The welcome arch takes me through to the CHAMPIONSHIP VILLAGE.



If I need help or advice, or information about the event, there are staff members who can help me at the

Accessibility & Information tent.



Once I am inside the CHAMPIONSHIP VILLAGE, it will be very busy with lots of people.



I can connect to free public wifi and

download the App for all Event Information and follow the action on the golf course.



I might also visit the bar and food vendors in the Championship Village.

There will be stage playing loud music in the Village. It will be busy.



I might visit the Official Merchandise

shop.



I can visit the 1st tee. Everyone is quiet

when the players are hitting the ball.



I will stay quiet when the player is taking their shot.



If I want a grandstand seat I can ask a

Marshal to show me where to sit.



There will be cheering and clapping when a player hits a good shot or makes a putt.



If the grandstands feel too busy, I can watch the golf on the open course.



The route out on the course is mostly grass and terrain and it can be uneven. There are also some areas of gravel and tarmac.



If I need assistance on the course, I can ask one of our event Marshals.



I can bring a folding chair for my own personal use. I must stay outside the

ropes.



There are many large screens around the

course where I can watch the golf.



I might also visit the bars and catering

units around the course.



Golf is an outside event and the weather can be changeable. I can check the weather forecast before my journey.



If I need to use the toilet, I can look for a sign or ask a staff member to direct me.



If I feel overstimulated and need a break, I can go to the Quiet Room next to the Championship Village.
