What can you expect?

- Creating Your Birth Support Plan: Discover what helps you feel safe and supported, learn how to share your wishes with the care team, and explore personal preferences for comfort, environment, and communication.
- Caring for You and Your Baby: Learn what to expect during the birth of the placenta and immediate recovery, explore ways to bond with your baby in the first hour (like skin-to-skin placement), and understand when certain bonding moments might be delayed for medical reasons and how to make choices about them.
