

DEFINITION

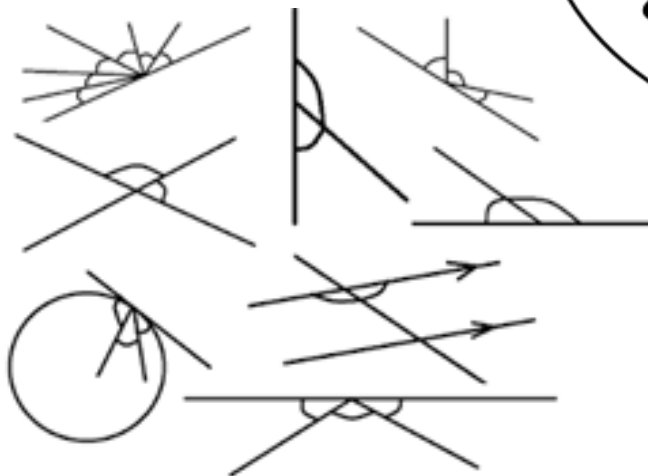
One or more angles connected at a point, where turning through each angle one after the other results in facing the opposite direction to the initial direction.

CHARACTERISTICS

- Two or more lines connected to a single point.
- The angles make a semicircle around the point
- The total turn is 180°
