JROTC instructors (MPOCs) will ensure the following:

- Assign a cadet to assist/support for transition needs
- JROTC cadet will escort Purple Star student(s) for a campus tour
 - o Classroom scheduled locations
 - o Cafeteria
 - o Auditorium
 - o Dean
 - o Nurse
 - o Media Center
 - o Transportation areas: student parking, bus entry/exit locations, etc.
 - o Military Wall of Honor location
 - o JROTC classroom
- Discuss JROTC enrollment and program opportunities.
- Serve as liaison for future questions, socialization opportunities, and resource data
- Coordinate JROTC annual projects to support the military community
 - o Participate in the Honor Flight program
 - o Partner with the Veteran Memorial Center during Thanksgiving and/or Christmas holidays to package food and stuff stocking for local and deployed military members/military families
 - o Assist with Wreaths Across America
 - o Support Yellow Ribbons events

- o Sponsor various functions to perpetuate military traditions and customs

MIHS faculty of Purple Star students will accomplish the following:

- Identify their military service/veteran status to connect better and build rapport, if applicable
- Have classmates identify their military family status, if applicable

MIHS administrators will conduct the following:

- Highlight/announce significant military holidays (i.e. Patriots Day, Military Birthdays, Veterans Day, Memorial Day, etc.)
- Celebrate April, the “Month of the Military Child,” and coordinate a Purple Up dress day and other events to honor Military families and Purple Star students.
