Description

Groups are an important part of life at Faith Baptist Church. They provide spaces where people can grow in their relationship with Jesus, build meaningful friendships, study God's Word together, and support one another through prayer and encouragement.

Our Groups ministry includes three types of groups that help people take next steps in faith and community:

- Life Groups – ongoing groups focused on spiritual growth, community, prayer, and living life together.
- Ministry Groups – short-term groups focused on a specific study, course, ministry experience, or area of discipleship.
- Support Groups – groups designed to provide Biblical care, encouragement, and healing for people walking through specific struggles, hurts, or life challenges.

Through gatherings in homes, classrooms, and ministry spaces, Groups help people experience authentic Christian community while growing as disciples of Jesus.

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Skills, Attributes, Knowledge

- All volunteers must have attended Faith Baptist Church for at least 6 months before actively serving.
 - A clear and growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ
 - Agreement with the mission, vision, and doctrinal beliefs of Faith Baptist Church
 - A genuine love for people and desire to help others grow spiritually
 - A willingness to build relationships and foster authentic Christian community
 - Commitment to supporting the leadership and unity of Faith Baptist Church
 - Ability to encourage spiritual growth through prayer, conversation, Biblical encouragement, and care
 - Faithfulness in supporting the vision and structure of the Groups ministry
 - Ability to create welcoming and safe environments for discussion, encouragement, and connection
 - Leaders and Coaches require additional experience, training, and approval from the Pastor of Training and Community Involvement.
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Days and Times

- Groups meet at various times throughout the week depending on the type of group and ministry season.
 - Life Groups typically meet weekly or biweekly on an ongoing basis.
 - Ministry Groups run for a defined season or study period.
 - Support Groups follow specific schedules based on the ministry focus and care needs of participants.
- Most groups meet in homes or at the church throughout Muskoka during weekday evenings, though some daytime opportunities are available.

Leaders, Hosts, and Coaches serve throughout the ministry year and participate in occasional training, encouragement, and leadership gatherings. Additional opportunities to serve may include helping launch new groups, mentoring new leaders, facilitating seasonal studies, or supporting special ministry initiatives.

Your first step towards serving is to attend **OnRamp**, a bi-monthly behind-the-scenes tour on a Sunday morning at Faith. At OnRamp, you'll have the opportunity to see Serve Teams in action, ask questions about any serving role at Faith.
