Program Description

The Minor in Christian Management provides faith-based leadership training, strategic planning for ministries, and ethical decision-making skills. Students will explore biblical leadership principles, Christian financial stewardship, and mission-driven management tailored for churches, religious nonprofits, and faith-based businesses.

This 69-credit hour program includes 30 credit hours of foundational project management and operations courses, 24 credit hours of core management and leadership training, 15 credit hours in Christian Management, elective coursework, a supervised practicum, and a research-based master's thesis.

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in business, management, or a related field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty or business professionals
- Statement of purpose outlining career goals in business, project management, and faith-based leadership
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Interview with faculty committee (if required)

Practicum Requirement

Students must complete a 300-hour supervised practicum in corporate operations, nonprofit leadership, or ministry-based management. Practicum placements include faith-based organizations, humanitarian initiatives, and corporate logistics teams.

Master's Thesis

Students are required to complete a research-based master's thesis exploring strategic project operations, supply chain optimization, or faith-based leadership in business management. The thesis should provide an applied research component with case studies, project implementation models, or ministry-focused applications.
