Your manager has asked you to find out about the many tourist attractions that can be found in the UK. You are to accurately locate them on a map.

### Task 1:

Your teacher will provide you with a set of maps of the UK.

He/she will show you the locations of approximately 60 different tourist attractions for you to mark on the maps.

In exam conditions and without reference to the maps; you will need to locate 42 of them, selected at random by your teacher. You need to achieve a minimum of 70% within 5mm.

They will consist of
