The city had been in crusader hands all his life, and from 1182 he started preparing to free it from them. In summer 1187, he defeated them at the Battle of Hittin. Weeks later, Jerusalem fell. For Muslims everywhere, this was a great moment.

In 1192, Salah Al-Din made peace with King Richard. By this act, people of both religions could travel there freely to Jerusalem. He died in Damascus in 1193.
