

Help accessing your @students.berkeley.net email

1. Your berkeley.net email is accessed through Gmail. Go to <http://mail.google.com>
Don't create an account -- you already have one! Find the sign-in box on the right.
2. Your username is your first and last name, and includes the ending "**@students.berkeley.net**". If your name is longer than 18 letters only enter the first 18.
3. Your password is the word "Berkeley" (with a capital "B"), and your student ID #.
