

#### **How to Use Kahoot**

Kahoot is a website that allows players to compete against each other in virtual quiz shows. The quiz show could be educational (math, science, geography, etc.) or just plain fun (music lyrics, emojis, movies, anything you can think of). Players can participate in existing quizzes (sometimes called "Kahoots") or create their own silly quizzes. Kahoot can be used as a fun activity during virtual play dates, group study sessions, brain breaks, Fun Fridays, and more.


Step 1 Visit Kahoot.com




# Step 2 – You are ready to share a quiz Option 1 – Quick & Easy

### Choose from a selection of existing quizzes


1. Click on Discover




2. You'll be taken to a page with several collections of quizzes, sorted by themes and subjects, to pick from.




3. Choose a quiz and click on it.




### 4. Click on Green Play button




## 5. Choose Host from the pop-up




6. Set your Game Options: music? Nickname generator? When you're done, click on Classic.




7. You'll be directed to a page with a pin number.




8. Give your guests a chance to go to kahoot.com

Your guests simply hit "Play" in the upper right corner of the screen.




9. Your guests will be directed to a page with a prompt asking for a pin number.




10. They will type in the pin you give from your hosted game, they will choose a nickname and then will be directed to a waiting screen



11. As soon as you are sure every guest has signed in with their nickname, click Start




12. You and your guests can go through the quiz together.
Kahoot keeps score and announces the winner at the end.




### Option 2 - Create your own quiz!


1. You can also choose to take a quick tutorial or just dive right in and click Create in upper right hand corner




2. From the pop-up, choose a template, or create your own questions.




3. You can add photos from the Kahoot library, or you can upload your own photos to personalize your quiz

- · When you're done, click on Classic
- You'll be directed to a page with a pin number.
- Give your guests a chance to log on to kahoot.comThere's no need for them to have an account. Your guests simply hit "Play" in the upper right corner of the screen.
- They will be directed to a page with a prompt asking for a pin number.
- They will type in the pin you give from your hosted game
- As soon as you are sure every guest has signed in with their nickname, click Start
