- I. Call to Order – Welcome
  - II. Adopt Agenda - Keith Szczudlak (1st); Jennifer Harrinton (2nd) Approved
  - III. New Business
    - A. 2024-2025 SPSA
      - 1. Monica Colunga put the SPSA on the screen and went over each section
      - 2. Aligned with WASC Action Plan
      - 3. Key findings for data - increase in ELD growth; transition to high school in math; new coordinator; math department will be implementing interventions for 4 years corresponding to elementary and middle school interventions; social emotional learning data from Annual Survey - low participation from parents and teachers, so the focus is on student data; 20% of students responded neutrally = need to identify we need clear student input; identified strong increase in students feeling safe on campus; College and Career Readiness = a-g completion has increased; sub groups declined in white students and 2 or more races. Priority focus areas correlate to WASC Action Plan: Executive Functioning Skills/AVID; Coping Mechanisms and resiliency in students to decrease levels of anxiety and stress in balance with academic performance; Funding for AVID and EL Programming
      - 4. We have been granted a 6-year Accreditation with a mid-cycle review.
      - 5. Vinod Kambrath motions to approve, Jodie Hoffman (seconds) - Approved
  - IV. Oral Communications
    - A. ELD - Ashleigh Frazer reports they completed ELPAC testing (131)
    - B. Faculty - Jennifer Harrington reports about articulation with Middle Schools and found similar challenges: homework, reading and doing better with questioning and research; finished scheduling to balance classes with appropriate rigor; Keith Szczudlak said that TA conferences were successful with great conversations/ parent recognizing that taking all the most rigorous courses isn't always necessary.
    - C. Parent - Jodie Hoffman asked about Adult Living - Keith Szczudlak said he is thinking about expanding the grade level of students who take the class. Gurudath Ramabhatt thanks Monica Colunga for her years of service. Monica Colunga expresses her appreciation for the School Site Council.
    - D. Student - David Palacios discusses access to classes such as Virtual Enterprise and suggests limiting to identify students who will participate.
