



Connections/Rounding Questions

Purpose of Rounding Visits:

- To help establish and foster trust between congregation and presbytery connections.
- To help each congregation see more clearly who they are as a faith community in their contexts and community.
- To learn more about each congregation.
- To encourage, affirm, support, and challenge each congregation as they live more fully into God's call.

Questions for pastors and sessions to consider:

1. Where have you **seen God at work** in your church this year?
2. What are **sources of energy and hope** for you as a congregation?
3. What are some of **your concerns, anxieties**, or fears?
4. What **changes have you seen** over the past several years?
5. Is there **anything else** you'd like your presbytery to know?
6. Are you aware of the new Presbytery structure?
