AED Location: 1st Floor - Entrance of Main Office

Examples of Medical Emergencies =

Loss of consciousness
New onset seizure
Severe injury with profuse bleeding
(*ie: dismembered limb, stab wound, gunshot wound*)
Difficulty breathing
Anaphylactic reaction (severe allergic reaction)
Heart attack symptoms
Stroke symptoms (*ie: numb/weakness in limbs & face, difficulty speaking and walking, confusion, dizziness, etc.*)

NOTES: The school nurse will alert staff of students with chronic medical conditions that may result in a medical emergency (*ie: students with diabetes, students with seizure disorders, etc.*) A specific emergency care plan will be shared for each student.

All Staff: Be prepared to assist nurse by
Calling 911
Radio school police
Clearing classroom/hallway
Printing student's demographic info for EMT personnel (main office staff)
Retrieving AED

In the event of a medical emergency:

Staff with 2-way Radio:

Stay calm & stay with the student

Radio school nurse and state clearly:
"We have an emergency in Room ##, student is experiencing [describe symptoms briefly]"

Staff without 2-way Radio:

If intercom is out of order, call 617.635.6789 via cell phone and/or send a student or colleague to health office to notify the nurse.
