COLLEGES - *College visit information is on your home page & also in College tab..*

- supermatch college search: Use over 20 criteria to find the schools best fit for you.
- college match: Once you have entered criteria (test scores, colleges applying to, etc) this tool provides a listing of colleges looking for students like you and a list of colleges that are most likely to overlap with the colleges on your list based on where students often apply.
- scholarship list: Alphabetical listing of all Exeter in house scholarships and some outside scholarships. Students will search and access links to applications through Naviance.
- enrichment programs: Search for a wide-range of enrichment opportunities hosted by colleges, universities and other organizations. COMMUNITY SERVICE: Community Service (local) opportunities can be found by searching “Exeter CS.” Check regularly for information on events such as May Days, Halloween Hayride, etc.

CAREERS

- explore clusters and careers: Career clusters are a way of grouping careers with common features and skills and can also help you better understand how your coursework in school can prepare you for certain types of careers.
- roadtrip nation interview archive: A journey of self-discovery to help you figure out who you are and what you love to do. After answering a few questions, you will be connected with inspiring video interviews from successful professionals
