This course is recommended for students in Grades 11-12.

Course Description: An introduction to welding careers, equipment and safety practices, including OSHA standards for industry. Basic mathematics; measuring systems; shop operations; use and care of precision measuring tools; and the use and care of hand and power tools. Instruction on various types of welding equipment and processes, basic welding gases, fluxes, rods, electrodes, symbols, and blueprints.
