1. Tournament Format

1.1. Platform

1.1.1. To participate, you must

- Have registered for the Apex Tournament on [Start.gg Apex](#)
 - Start.gg will be used for match assignments, bracketing, and score reporting.
- Complete the [Google Form](#)
- Join the [Bronco Esports Discord](#) and obtain the FFF2023 Apex role.
- Read through all the rules below

1.2. Format

1.2.1. In this tournament, each team plays every other team in a six (6) match series, with teams accumulating points from each match as described in **APPENDIX 4.2**. At the end of these 6 matches, the **top team** with the highest accumulated points will be awarded a prize.

1.2.2. You will create your own Team of 3.

1.2.3. Twenty (20) teams will start and play in the same custom lobby throughout the whole tournament.

1.2.4. The Lobby is first come first serve once the 20 teams are filled. The sign up will be close on the start time of the tournament.

1.3. Seeding

1.3.1. Seeding will be randomized by the tournament organizers

2. Player and Account Rules

2.1. Player Accounts

2.1.1. A player may only register one steam account or origin account on start.gg to be used during the tournament. This account username must match the listed account on the forum.

2.1.2. A player may not share their account with another player or use another player's account.

3. Match Rules

3.1. Lobby Hosting

3.1.1. A tournament administrator will host the lobby and is responsible for inviting players and setting up the lobby

3.1.2. Players must show up within 10 minutes of the start time of the match or else they will forfeit their spot in that match and must wait for the next one.

3.1.3. The lobby will start automatically. Unless agreed upon by the teams to take a intermission. There will be a max 5 minute intermission between each match.

3.2. Match Settings

3.2.1. Matches will follow normal ALGS competitive rules

- 1 person from each team will pick a spot on the map for their teammates to land at. Each spot like Down Beast or Tree on the map teams can claim that spot for their team to land.
- We will be using Landing Spot Picker to choose your own POIs.

3.2.2. **Map Selection**

- The map rotation will be as follows:
 - Map 1: Storm Point
 - Map 2: Storm Point
 - Map 3: Storm Point
 - Map 4: World Edge
 - Map 5: World Edge
 - Map 6: World Edge

3.3. Score Reporting

3.3.1. After each match is complete, each team is responsible for submitting a screenshot of their placement and kills to the **#scores** in discord. Game summary screenshots must be posted in the channel **#scores**. Teams are also responsible for verifying each score. If there is a dispute between kills and placement, tournament moderators will refer to the match summary screenshots.

3.4. Scoring

3.4.1. The points awarded in each Match are:

- Placements:
 - 1st: 12
 - 2nd: 9
 - 3rd: 7
 - 4th: 5

- 5th: 4
- 6th – 7th: 3
- 8th – 10th: 2
- 11th – 15th: 1
- 16th – 20th: 0
- Kills
 - 1 for each kill

4. **Disconnections**

4.1. If a player disconnects from the lobby in-game prior to the first two circle closing, we will do a full restart. When the 2nd circle closes, the team must play with their 2 remaining players and no restart will be given.

5. **Streaming**

5.1. Players are free to livestream their matches on a streaming platform of their choosing.

5.2. Teams are required to put on a 5-minute delay on their choice of streaming platform.

5.3. While streaming, players are required to set up the following:

5.3.1. Include “Frag Fest Spring 2023” in your streaming title.

5.3.2. Post your channel #tft-streamers where you can advertise your stream link.

5.4. The Frag Fest Spring 2023 organizers reserve the right to stream any games conducted as part of the tournament.

6. **Misconduct**

6.1. **Cheating**

6.1.1. All cheats, third-party applications, game file modifications, and bug exploits that can be used to give players unfair advantages are prohibited. Using any cheat will result in disqualification. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Radar hacks
- Wallhacks
- Speed hacks
- Aim hacks
- Hitbox manipulation
- Teleportation
- Stream Sniping

6.1.2. Over-the-shoulder or virtual coaching, smurfing, and account sharing are also considered cheating.

6.2. **Toxicity and Unsportsmanlike Behavior**

6.2.1. Toxicity and unsportsmanlike behavior towards any other person involved in this tournament will not be tolerated and can result in disqualification. If told by the tournament organizer to change your nickname, you must do so or face potential disqualification.

6.2.2. Tbagging and shooting death boxes are allowed and if both teams consent in doing so.

Frag Fest Spring 2023 reserves the right to monitor any player, for any reason, during the tournament in addition to minor changes to these rules. This tournament is not affiliated with EA or Respawn
