

Connect to WiFi then head back to the Motorola terms page and click the privacy policy, then about, then website privacy policy, then about then u should see support link click it, then click the person icon and login with motorola account. double tap the text in the login box. Click share, message, new message. Enter in www.youtube.com, send, click load preview, and again click it. You should be in chrome now. If the set lock pattern does not work(bit.ly/direct_frp or any frp site you like), the other method is to continuously login to the Google account to get play services to show in battery usage. Before doing this though, you should go and enable accessibility menu and go to storage-apps-YouTube and clear its data. This will allow you to use the above method to get back into chrome. Once play services is in the battery usage(if accessibility menu enabled use it and assistant to get into settings by saying "open settings") click it and press disable, force stop. Goto storage and find play services and clear it. Go back to the 1st screen, then in WiFi you should now have the option to skip, if so get back into chrome and enable play services again then do setup offline. If it's not then try going till it starts looping the please wait stuff then go back and see if it allows you. If not still, get back into chrome(every time you get into chrome always clear YouTube in storage) and then in settings-storage clear the cache on android setup and and play services then check again. You don't want to reboot the phone as play services will no longer be in battery usage.
