At the Mock Reading Workshop:

- Teachers will be trained to deconstruct prompts and apply the 6 point rubric provided by the College Board to score essays.
- Under the instruction of Mock Reading Leadership, teachers will collaborate with other teacher readers at their table to evaluate essays and develop an understanding of targeted instruction to be addressed between the Mock Reading Workshop and the AP Literature and AP Language exams in May.
- Students and teachers will benefit from evaluation of scoring data following the event that will help guide remaining instructional and review time prior to the exam.
- Teachers will receive targeted professional development to address student instructional needs for both AP writing and college level writing.
