

Healthcare in Washington, D.C.

Washington, D.C., stands as a national center for patient care and medical research, hosting a total of 16 medical centers and hospitals within its boundaries. Efforts to improve healthcare access have included expanding health-care options to uninsured residents and commissioning studies to prescribe solutions. Notably, the District enabled 911 operators to divert callers seeking medical

help to a registered nurse, helping to make telehealth appointments or arrange clinic visits.

Educational and Research Institutions

The city is also home to several medical schools and associated teaching hospitals, contributing to its reputation as a

center for medical education and research. These include:

- The George Washington University Medical Center: Treated President Reagan in 1981 after a failed assassination

attempt.

- Georgetown University Hospital: Home to the Lombardi Cancer Center.

Public Health Initiatives

Washington, D.C., has launched various public health initiatives to address disparities, including efforts to combat HIV. Despite being a national leader in HIV prevention, the city has faced challenges in reducing the disease's impact among

Black residents.
