

Preparing for Driver Ed/Practice Permit Tests

- YOU SHOULD HAVE YOUR LEARNER PERMIT BY THE FIRST WEEK OF CLASS!
 Check multiple Driver License Divisions if the one you wanted to go to is backed up. Here is a website with all the info you need about getting a permit:

- You will need to take a written test before you can get your permit. You can take the test at the Driver License Division or at Brighton High School. Permit Test Schedule at Brighton:

1st Trimester

Tuesday-Thursday during APP class in Mr. Knoble's room (2206)

2nd Trimester

Wednesday-after school from 2:30-3:30pm in the weight room with Coach Merhish Friday-after school from 12:15-1:00pm in Mr. Knoble's room (2206)

3rd Trimester

Wednesday-during APP class in the weight room with Coach Merhish Friday-after school from 12:15-1:00pm in Mr. Knoble's room (2206)

*There is no fee or appointment needed to take the permit test at Brighton.

- There is a required in-person parent/guardian meeting that EVERYONE will need to attend. More details will be given on the dates at Brighton. Please visit https://zerofatalities.com/parent-night/ for more information.
- Please study the Utah Driver Handbook that is handed out to you. It will help you
