

THE BEGINNING

The Steinadler Association was founded in 1919 by Adler Miller, a WWI veteran returning from fighting in the war. The family was an extremely wealthy organization, they got a majority of their money off of politics and background crime. At the time the Golden Eagle crime family was one of the most notorious crime families in Berlin led by Muller Miller. Muller held every territory in Berlin, after WWI he took advantage seeing as the majority of his opposition were either killed or suffered financially. Politics was growing rampantly in Germany, but Muller did not care as much as he did for his money, money was his top priority and would later be his downfall. Gustav Flesch and Frederick Steiner were Muller's brothers, they all started from scratch, they were born and raised poor, that was until Muller and his brothers decided to take action. The brothers started off slow by making beer, rum, wine and Vodka, which made them extremely opulent in Germany. After their successful run with alcohol they wanted more so they started making and selling drugs such as Morphine and Cocaine. Gustav Flesch and Frederick Steiner went straight into politics as soon as they got their money income where they wanted it. Muller Miller decided to stay in the crime family and started to recruit massively all around Berlin and got in total of 2,245 members throughout Berlin, majority were normal civilians while the smaller half were policing officials.

the fall of The Ringvereine Crime Family in Germany

1929 September the 1st Muller Miller gets word that his son Lerry Miller has entered the military as a Commissioned Officer. Muller Miller's business was going smoothly; his brothers were now the head of a political party called the " Social Democratic Party " Which was met with hostility by the " NSDAP ". The date was 3/4/1932 A unknown mysterious man knocked on Gustav Flesch door to which Gustav answered and was met with four bullets in his body and two in his head, the news was spreading like wildfire when Muller Miller and Frederick Steiner heard about the news they were outraged and swore to get vengeance for his brother.

4/18/1932 Tensions are starting to grow as Muller Miller has his men running around the streets of Berlin looking for the man that killed his brother. 4/20/1932 Frederick Steiner was making a speech about his brother at his funeral as he was speaking he was then shot multiple times by a driveby, 4 other bystanders were injured due to crossfire. 5/8/1932 Muller Miller is coming back from Potsdam to find that his house had been ransacked and that his brother died in a driveby.

1/15/1933 Muller Miller was sitting in his car about to leave Germany and travel to America for his last resort to continue his crime family. When Muller attempted to start his car it had a slight stutter and exploded. 1/16/1933 Lerry Miller was pulled to the side by his Commanding Officer and was told that his Father died due to natural causes and was allowed to take some time off. Lerry Miller knew of his father's crime family and wanted to take over as his successor, a newspaper came his way, showing him the truth about his Father's death, Lerry Miller was furious but he knew if they found out he was dead. Lerry Miller packed all of his belongings, including his military uniform and left for the United States Of America before

the military knew. Lerry Miller knew that if he was going to follow his father's, footsteps he would need to do it in another country and start off slow just like his father did. He would travel to a city called " Union City " and there he would make history.
